ALREADY?

With four regular season games under their belt, and three for the opposition, Lubbock Christian University must prepare for their Lone Star Conference opener, as the Lady Chaparrals open LSC play on the road Saturday in San Angelo, Texas facing Angelo State University at 2 p.m. The Lady Chaps are 4-0 on the season, with a 1-0 mark in true road games. LCU's contest in the Concho Valley kicks off a three-game road trip, as they will follow with a Thanksgiving tournament next week in San Antonio, Texas.

SWEEPING HONORS

The Lone Star Conference has recognized Lubbock Christian University's Maddi Chitsey (Offensive) and Juliana Robertson (Defensive) as their Women's Basketball Players of the Week.

Chitsey helped LCU to a 2-0 week, with home victories over Colo. Colorado Springs (UCCS) and No. 20 Southwestern Oklahoma State, leading LCU in scoring on the week with an average of 18 points a game. Against UCCS, Chitsey posted

10 points in the opening half and ended with 16 points in 19 minutes of playing time. She followed with a +18 plus/minus against SWOSU, leading all scorers with 20 points off an 8-of-14 shooting performance. Chitsey was 8-of-10 shooting inside the arc and also was 6-of-6 from the free-throw line. The senior from Wall, Texas contributed two blocks and two assists in the win as well.

Robertson played a vital defensive role in LCU's two wins. She had two steals, four assists and seven points in a win over UCCS, and then followed with a career-high 12 rebounds and career-high four blocks against SWOSU. Robertson also had a steal and provided a pair of assists in the SWOSU contest. The junior from Kerrville, Texas also provided an offensive spark, as her lone field goal against SWOSU helped provide LCU's final lead change, as they came back from a five-point deficit against SWOSU for their 67th consecutive home victory. Robertson was part of an LCU defense that held the opposition to a 28.7% shooting percentage, including holding nationally ranked SWOSU to a 28.8% shooting mark.

The honors are the first for either player and are LCU's first LSC weekly accolades in women's basketball (LCU is in their first season competing in the LSC).

CONFERENCE OPENERS

This season marks LCU's first season in the Lone Star Conference. Lone Stars Conference play opened Thursday night with a trio of games opening the conference slate. LCU's LSC opener is their 26th conference opener after six Heartland Conference and 19 Sooner Athletic Conference openers. The Lady Chaps went 11-8 all-time in SAC openers and 5-1 in HC openers, with a loss at St. Mary's (Dec. 31, 2016) marking their only loss in a Heartland Conference opener. They are 14-2 all-time in conference openers under head coach Steve Gomez. They have won 13 of their prior 14 consecutive conference openers.

WHO IS COUNTING?

LCU's 4-0 start marks the fourth season out of the prior five seasons in which LCU has started at least 4-0 on the season. The Lady Chaps opened last season 5-0 and the 2017-18 season 6-0. Their best start and season was their 2015-16 season in which they went 35-0. LCU is one of five unbeaten teams in the LSC and there are 52 unbeaten teams in Division II.

HANDLE ON THINGS

LCU leads the Lone Star Conference in assist/turn-over ratio with a mark of 1.25, which ranks 32nd nationally. An interesting statistic, considering LCU's individual leader (Allie Schulte with a 1.00) ranks 18th individually in the LSC. LCU ranks 41st nationally with an average of 13.3 turnovers per game (second in the conference) and their mark of 16.5 assists per game is 39th nationally (third in the LSC).

WHEN AT HOME

LCU went 15-0 last season inside Rip Griffin Center. With LCU's win 71-61 win Saturday over No.20 Southwestern Oklahoma State, LCU extended their active home win streak to 67 games, which ranks third all-time in NCAA Division II women's basketball (it actively leads NCAA Div. II). The record is 87 consecutive home victories by Nebraska-Kearney, who completed the task from Jan. 31, 1995 - Nov. 24, 2001. LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix, has also won 55 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

Based on the preseason rankings for the 2019-20 season (D2SIDA, WBCA along with Lone Star Conference), the Lady Chaparrals carry the highest expectations in program history to start a season. D2SIDA placed the defending national champions No.1 and the WBCA ranked LCU No.2 despite the Lady Chaps receiving 14 of the 23 first place votes. Each ranking is their highest preseason ranking in program history. The LSC preseason ranked LCU

No.1 in their preseason rankings. The first national in-season rankings came out this week and LCU remained No.1 in the WBCA and No.2 in D2SIDA polls.

BLOCK PARTIES ARE BACK

LCU ranks 12th nationally in blocks (22) and 15th in blocks per game (5.5). Maddi Chitsey leads the team with nine blocks (third in the conference and tied for 22nd nationally), at a pace of 2.25 per game (third in the conference and 28th nationally). LCU has ranked in the top-10 nationally in blocks each season since the 2015-16 season, which was their first season eligible to have statistics included among NCAA leaders. They ranked 10th in total blocks last season (155), second in 2017-18 (202, ranking fourth with a pace of 6.1 per game), fourth in 2016-17 (170, leading the nation with 5.7 per game) and led NCAA Division II in 2015-16 with 235 blocks (6.7 per game).

CHARITY WORK

LCU went 28-of-34 (82.4%) from the free-throw line last weekend, which included Madelyn Turner (8-of-8) and Maddi Chitsey (6-of-6) go a combined 14-of-14 from the line. The Lady Chaps are 78.1% from the line this season and lead the LSC in free-throw percentage (ranking 22nd nationally). In each season LCU has been eligible to have team statistics included among NCAA Division II leaders (2015-15), the Lady Chaps have finished in the top-three in their conference in free-throw shooting. They led the Heartland Conference in 2017-18 with a 76.2% mark from the line, ranking 33rd nationally. Their highest national ranking is 32nd (75.0%) from the 2015-16 season. Turner leads LCU and ranks third in the LSC and 41st nationally with a 92.9% shooting mark from the line. There are 25 qualified players with a 100% shooting mark from the free-throw line in NCAA Division II.

GO-GO

LCU head coach Steve Gomez claimed his 400th win on Friday, Nov.15 in LCU's win over Colo. Colorado Springs (UCCS). Gomez, the winningest coach in LCU women's basketball history, is 401-122 all-time and his 17th season at the helm of the Lady Chaps, for a win percentage of 76.7%.

FIVE THINGS ABOUT ASU

1 > The Belles are coming off a 26-6 campaign in 2018-19, as they were regular season co-champions of the LSC with a 17-3 record. They went 10-2 at home last season and have won seven straight games at home carrying over from last season. The Belles qualified for the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament last season, leading to a regional championship game in which they fell to LCU 76-70. ASU has had their season end with losses to LCU the past two seasons and three of the past four seasons.

2 > ASU is preseason picked third in the LSC Preseason Poll. They received one first-place vote.

3 > Angelo State is 2-1 this season after splitting an Arkansas road trip last week. They fell to Harding 89-67, but rebounded with a 92-90 win at Arkansas Tech. Their lone and prior home game this season resulted in a 78-67 win over Texas Wesleyan (Nov. 12). ASU has won their prior three conference openers, with their only conference-opener at home in span resulting in a win to open the

4 > Nate Harris is in his first season at the helm of the Belles. Harris was an assistant coach last season for the Belles following an assistant coaching stint at Montana State.

5 > De'Anira Moore averages 8.0 rebounds per game, leading the LSC and ranking tied for 38th nationally with 4.0 offensive rebounds per game.

THE SERIES AGAINST ASU

LCU leads the series with a 10-3 all-time mark. LCU defeated ASU 76-70 in last season's South Central Region Tournament (Mar. 19, 2019) in Lubbock, and marked the sixth consecutive win over ASU and the third straight in a NCAA postseason game. The last regular season meeting was on Nov. 24, 2014 in San Angelo. LCU won the game 71-57 (that is the prior meeting in San Angelo) and improved to 4-1 all-time in San Angelo. The two teams have met five times since 2012, but had not met since Nov. 30, 2001 prior to that. The last ASU win in the series was a 62-56 ASU victory on Dec. 29, 2000. The Belles only home win in the series was a 75-59 win on Dec. 1, 1992.

PREVIOUS RECAP VS. ASU

Mar. 19, 2019 (Lubbock, Texas) – LCU:76 - ASU:70

Maddi Chitsey posted a double-double (26 points and 10 rebounds) and Olivia Robertson contributed 22 points, as their 48 combined points helped No.24/25 Lubbock Christian University claim an Elite Eight Tournament berth with a 76-70 victory over No.4-seed Angelo State Tuesday night inside an energetic Rip Griffin Center.

The opening half was game of scoring surges. The Lady Chaps connected on their first four field goal attempts, with three-pointers by Allie Schulte and Caitlyn Cunyus in the mix, leading to a 12-0 run to open the game. Schulte ended up with seven points in the quarter and LCU led 20-9 through the opening 10 minutes of the game.

The Belles overcame the 12-point deficit in the second quarter by outscoring LCU 27-13 in the quarter and closing the half on a 9-0 run to take a 36-33 lead into the locker room. Robertson (8 points) and Chitsey (5 points) were the only Lady Chaps to score in the second quarter, while the Belles received production from six different players in the quarter, including a combined 16 points from Marquita Daniels (9 points) and De'Anira Moore (7 points).

ASU took advantage of an 11-4 foul advantage with a 10-2 scoring advantage from the free-throw line in the first half. Each team had a player in double figures in the first half, as Robertson led LCU with 12 points and Moore produced 10 in the half for ASU.

LCU knocked down four of their first five shot attempts of the third quarter, and a 20-7 run to start the quarter allowed LCU to take a 53-43 lead. Maddi Chitsey had 10 points in the quarter and LCU lead 56-48 with 1:52 remaining in the third quarter before ASU went on a run to close the third quarter.

The Belles cut LCU's lead to 56-54 a minute into the fourth quarter. LCU responded with an 11-0 run, start by a trio of Bobbi Chitsey free-throws and a long distance three-pointer from Maddi Chitsey. ASU was not to be counted out, as with 38 seconds remaining, Dezirae Hampton hit a three-pointer to cut LCU's lead to 73-70. LCU did not have a field goal in the final 2:33 of the game, but free-throws allowed them to hold on. ASU HAD A 6-of-8 shooting sequence going until closing out the game missing their final three shot attempts.

Angelo was led by All-Tournament Team selection Marquita Daniels in the loss. She produced five steals in the game and posted a game-high 27 points. They also received 16 points from Moore and 11 points from Maria Delgado. The Belles have had their season end in Lubbock three of the past four seasons and this season came to an end with a 26-6 record.

LCU was led by Maddi Chitsey, who was two points off a career-high in scoring, and she completed her second double-double of the season. Robertson posted her third consecutive game of at least 20 points with her 22 points (second time this season she has had such a sequence). All of LCU's scoring came from their five starters, as for the first time this season, LCU did not have any scoring from their bench.

In 10 seasons at the helm while an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons at the helm, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the results have not changed since transitioning. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season. That led to a remarkable 2015-2016 season. A season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually a NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2015-16 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

In 16 seasons at LCU (the 2019-20 season marks his 17th), Gomez enters the 2019-2020 season with a 397-122 collegiate coaching record. He also enters his squad into Lone Star Conference play for the first time. He completed Heartland Conference play with a 118-17 (.874) overall record.

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific.

LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University.

In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU.

LCU had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded.

In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 29 years, and the couple has two children: Hayden and Landon.



VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His

first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011.



KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She played an integral role in the coaching staff when the Lady Chaps went on to win the NCAA Div. II National Championship in the 2015-16 season. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

LCU Overcomes Six-Point Second-Half Deficit to Extend Home Win Streak To 67 Wins

Lubbock Christian University used a 24-9 scoring advantage in the fourth quarter to overcome a 52-47 deficit and defeat No. 20 Southwestern Oklahoma State 71-61 in the final game of the TAJ Hospitality Classic inside Rip Griffin Center Saturday evening. The meeting matched the two programs who appeared in the NCAA Division II national championship game last season in Columbus, Ohio, which LCU won in double-overtime for their second national championship in program history.

Double overtime was needed to decide the winner in March and the thoughts of overtime Saturday were entering people's mindset after eight lead changes and neither team producing more than a six-point lead through the first seven lead changes.

Neither team was able to get into a solid shooting rhythm, but there was a brief glimpse of a heavyweight bout with tiring haymakers thrown and it came in the third quarter. With 6:24 left in the third quarter, Caitlyn Cunyus connected on a three-pointer to give LCU a 40-35 lead and their largest lead of the game. SWOSU responded by ending a 0-for-7 shooting sequence by knocking down five consecutive field goal attempts. The Bulldogs made four straight three-point field goals (two by Makyra Tramble and two by Taber Beer) and the 17-6 scoring advantage over a four-minute stretch turned the Lady Chaps lead into a 52-46 SWOSU advantage.

The scoring surge for SWOSU led to a 52-47 Bulldogs lead heading into the fourth quarter. The hot shooting did not follow the Bulldogs into the fourth quarter though, as they missed five consecutive shots (all three-point attempts) made one field goal over a span of 14 shot attempts. Meanwhile, LCU, following a three-point miss to open the quarter, made five of their next six shot attempts and it led to a 12-3 LCU run for a 59-55 LCU lead four minutes into the fourth quarter. Allie Schulte, who had not had scored since a first-quarter field goal, was 3-of-5 from the field in the fourth quarter and scored seven points. Her contributions, along with a 14-6 rebound margin, a 12-4 scoring edge in the paint and a 10-of-14 performance from the free-throw line in the fourth quarter contributed to LCU outscoring SWOSU 24-9 in the quarter. SWOSU, who ended the first half making two of their final 10 field goal attempts, ended the game making one of their final 12 field goal attempts in the game. They were 2-of-17 in the fourth quarter, shooting 11.8% in the frame.

Outside of personnel and location, if there was a big difference in the play of the game from last season's championship game meeting, it was the "whistles." In the championship game, which involved an additional 10 minutes of play (two overtimes), the two teams combined for 39 free-throw attempts and 32 fouls were called. Saturday, the two teams were whistled for 47 fouls and it led to 54 free-throw attempts. LCU out-scored SWOSU 22-18 from the line.

There were seven lead changes in the first half. SWOSU, thriving off an 8-0 run, had an 18-17 lead after the opening quarter. Maddie Sperle led SWOSU with 14 points in the half. LCU was 5-of-14 (35.7%) from the field in each of the first two quarters and received 10 points from Maddi Chitsey to lead to a 33-33 halftime score.

LCU's 53.8% shooting in the fourth quarter led them to a 40.7% shooting mark for the game (22/54). Chitsey led all scorers with 20 points and was a +18 in plus/minus. LCU also received 12 points from Ashton Duncan (also added a +14 plus/minus) and 11 points from Laynee Burr. Juliana Robertson (12) and Cunyus (nine) each posted career-high rebound marks for LCU. Robertson also posted a career-high four blocks.

SWOSU, falling to 3-1 on the season, received 19 points from Sperle. Freshman Tramble was solid for the Bulldogs, posting 11 points, six assists and four steals. Beer finished the game with four three-pointers and 12 points. The Bulldogs were 28.8% (17/59) from the field. The two teams were plagued by a combined 35 turnovers (19 by LCU), which led to a 22-10 scoring advantage in points-off-turnovers for SWOSU.

TURNING POINT

Taber Beer of SWOSU was plagued by foul trouble in the game. Beer, who led the team with a +7 plus/minus and was one of two Bulldogs in the positive in the stat-line, had nailed back-to-back three-pointers in the third quarter during their sequence of five-straight made field goals before fouling out. She fouled out 24 seconds into the fourth quarter, as LCU out-scored SWOSU 24-9 after her departure. She was 4-of-8 from three-point range, while the rest of the team was a combined 5-of-28 (17.9%). SWOSU missed their final 10 three-point attempts.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

SWOSU fired up 36 three-point attempts in the game, shooting 25% (9/36) from long range. Since LCU joined NCAA Division II, the top three games in opponent three-point field goal attempts have all been held by SWOSU, as they attempted 38 in March's championship game and 37 on Dec. 10, 2016 against LCU.
