ANYONE, ANYTIME

No.1 Lubbock Christian University head coach Steve Gomez has always had the "anyone, anytime" approach when scheduling competition. UConn, Texas Tech, Texas, Mississippi State and Baylor are just some of the opponents the Lady Chaps have agreed to play over the past, and whether its Division I, Division II or even NAIA powerhouses LCU has placed on the schedule, it is always unknown how it plays out. This season's schedule is a prime example. Moving into the Lone Star Conference, LCU knows their conference schedule will be beefy, but it did not deter Gomez from scheduling a tough non-conference schedule. The public-eye will grasp the toughness of an exhibition schedule consisting of Texas, Baylor and Mississippi State, but they may not grasp the current schedule swing the Lady Chaparrals are amidst heading into the Thanksgiving Break (or lack thereof a break). LCU just concluded wins over No. 20 Southwestern State (defend-

ing national finalist) and Angelo State (defending Lone Star Conference co-champions and regional finalist), and now head to San Antonio, Texas for a third consecutive season to compete in the St. Mary's Thanksgiving Classic inside Bill Greehey Arena. Awaiting in the Alamo City is Southern Nazarene (4-0) and Central Oklahoma (5-1), who are a combined 9-1 on the season. Toss in the prior two LCU opponents and that is a stretch of opponents that are a combined 15-5 on the season, with two of the losses provided by LCU wins. Going back to this weekend's opponents and their combined 9-1 record... UCO's one loss was in a double overtime loss to SNU.

SLAM DUNC

Offensive Player of the Week.

Duncan helped LCU open Lone Star Conference play 1-0, as her 24-point performance led LCU to a 75-64 road win at Angelo State. The Lubbock, Texas native, making her 54th career appearance, made her first career start and opened the game 5-of-5 from the field, which was part of a 8-of-9 shooting sequence to start the game. Duncan's 24-point production was a career-high. The junior connected on four three-pointers and also contributed four rebounds and two steals in the game.

The honor comes one week after Maddi Chitsey (offensive) and Juliana Robertson (defensive) swept the LSC weekly honors. Three recipients on the season tops last season, as LCU claimed two weekly honors in the Heartland Conference.

LONE STAR DEBUT

Playing conference games in December is not out of the norm, but playing a conference match in November was a little different, although expected with LCU playing in their first season in the 18-team Lone Star Conference. Saturday, LCU defeated Angelo State 75-64 and it was LCU's first conference game in November since hosting Oklahoma Panhandle State (Nov. 21, 2013) and Newman (Nov. 23, 2013) during the 2013-14 season. LCU's LSC opener was their 27th conference opener and their first in the LSC after six Heartland Conference and 19 Sooner Athletic Conference openers. The Lady Chaps went 11-8 all-time in SAC openers and 5-1 in HC openers, with a loss at St. Mary's (Dec. 31, 2016) marking their only loss in a Heartland Conference opener. The win Saturday improved LCU to 15-2 all-time in conference openers under head coach Steve Gomez. They have won 14 of their prior 15 consecutive conference openers.

WHO IS COUNTING?

LCU's 5-0 start marks the fourth season out of the prior five seasons in which LCU has started at least 5-0 on the season. The Lady Chaps opened last season 5-0 and the 2017-18 season 6-0. Their best start and season was their 2015-16 season in which they went 35-0. LCU is one of two unbeaten teams in the LSC and there are 35 unbeaten teams in Division II.

HANDLE ON THINGS

LCU ranks second in the Lone Star Conference in assist/turnover ratio with a mark of 1.10, which ranks 50th nationally. It is an interesting statistic, considering LCU does not have anyone in the top-10 individually in the category. LCU ranks 34th nationally with an average of 13.4 turnovers per game (second in the conference) and their mark of 14.8 assists per game is sixth in the LSC.

ALMOST THERE

Maddi Chitsey enters the Thanksgiving tournament with 998 career points, needing two points to hit the 1,000-point mark in her LCU career. The senior has averaged 11.1 points in her LCU career and Friday will mark her 91st career game. She will serve as the only 1,000-point scorer actively on the squad, as the last member to reach 1,000 career points in her LCU career was Olivia Robertson, who accomplished the task Mar. 15, 2019.

BLACK FRIDAY

LCU is in their third consecutive season attending the Thanksgiving Classic hosted by St. Mary's. The Lady Chaps are 2-2 all-time in the classic and have never won two games in a single-season at the event. This season marks the third consecutive season a defending national champion attended the event. Ashland attended in 2017 and Central Missouri played in the event last season. The last time LCU attended a "Thanksgiving tournament" and went 2-0 was in 2015, as they defeated Clayton State and Rollins College at the Rollins Thanksgiving Tournament in Winter Park, Fla.

WHEN AT HOME

LCU went 15-0 last season inside Rip Griffin Center. With LCU's win 71-61 on Saturday over No.20 Southwestern Oklahoma State, LCU extended their active home win streak to 67 games, which ranks third all-time in NCAA Division II women's basketball (it actively leads NCAA Div. II). The record is 87 consecutive home victories by Nebraska-Kearney, who completed the task from Jan. 31, 1995 - Nov. 24, 2001. LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix, has also won 55 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

Based on the preseason rankings for the 2019-20 season (D2SIDA, WBCA along with Lone Star Conference), the Lady Chaparrals carry the highest expectations in program history to start a season. D2SIDA placed the defending national champions No.1 and the WBCA ranked LCU No.2 despite the Lady Chaps receiving 14 of the 23 first place votes. Each ranking is their highest preseason ranking in program history. The LSC preseason ranked LCU No.1 in their preseason rankings. The second national in-season rankings came out this week and LCU remained No.1 in the WBCA and No.2 in D2SIDA polls.

BLOCK PARTIES ARE BACK

LCU ranks 25th nationally in blocks (26) and 16th in blocks per game (5.2). Maddi Chitsey leads the team with 12 blocks (third in the conference and tied for 22nd nationally), at a pace of 2.4 per game (second in the conference and 18th nationally). LCU has ranked in the top-10 nationally in blocks each season since the 2015-16 season, which was their first season eligible to have statistics included among NCAA leaders. They ranked 10th in total blocks last season (155), second in 2017-18 (202, ranking fourth with a pace of 6.1 per game), fourth in 2016-17 (170, leading the nation with 5.7 per game) and led NCAA Division II in 2015-16 with 235 blocks (6.7 per game).

CHARITY WORK

LCU are 28-of-34 (82.4%) from the free-throw line at home, which includes Madelyn Turner (8-of-8) and Maddi Chitsey (6-of-6) combining for a 14-of-14 mark from the line at home. The Lady Chaps were 8-of-9 Saturday at Angelo State from the line and are 79.3% from the line this season and lead the LSC in free-throw percentage (ranking 21st nationally). In each season LCU has been eligible to have team statistics included among NCAA Division II leaders (2015-15), the Lady Chaps have finished in the top-three in their conference in free-throw shooting. They led the Heartland Conference in 2017-18 with a 76.2% mark from the line, ranking 33rd nationally. Their highest national ranking is 32nd (75.0%) from the 2015-16 season. Turner leads LCU and ranks third in the LSC and 28th nationally with a 92.9% shooting mark from the line. There are nine qualified players with a 100% shooting mark from the free-throw line in NCAA Division II.

MORE CHARITY NOTES

Saturday at Angelo State, the Belles had a 21-9 advantage in free-throw attempts, as LCU was whistled for 19 fouls (compared to 10 fouls against ASU). The 12-shot-attempt

differential matched their biggest margin last season, as St Edward's had a 17-5 advantage on Mar. 9, 2019. The last time LCU was whistled for at least nine more fouls than their opponent was on Dec. 14, 2013, as they were whistled for 27 fouls and Oklahoma Christian was called for 18 fouls.

BE DEFENSIVE

The Lady Chaps lead the LSC and rank 16th nationally, holding opponents to a 32% shooting mark on the season. Of their five contests, LCU has held the opponent to under a 30% shooting mark and the highest shooting percentage they have allowed in a game was 36.8% by Metro State (Nov. 9).

FIVE THINGS ABOUT SNU

1 > The Crimson Storm are coming off a 17-13 campaign in 2018-19, finishing tied for third in the Great American Conference (GAC) with a 15-7 record. They went 1-4 in neutral site play last season and faced a tough slate with five games against ranked opponents (went 0-5 in those game).

2 > SNU is preseason picked fourth in the GAC Pre-season Poll. The GAC has opened conference play and SNU (5-0 overall) is 2-0 in conference play and are atop their conference standings in a four-way tie.

3 > Abby Niehues earned the GAC Defensive Player of the Year after she finished the season as one of nine players in Division II to block at least 100 shots. She is 16th nationally this season with 13 points, with a mark of 3.25 per game ranking ninth nationally. She is teamed with Myriam Garcia, who ranks 11th nationally with 2.75 blocks per game. As a team, SNU ranks third

in the nation with 7.0 blocks per game and 19th with 28 blocks as a team.
 4 > The Crimson Storm rank 14th nationally with a 40.7% shooting mark from three-point range. Jaycee Soap averages 3.25 three-point field goals per game, which ranks 24th nationally. Kennedy Gillette averages 2.0 three-pointers per game and is successful at a 66.7% clip, ranking second in the nation.

5 > Gillette not only connects at a successful rate from long-range, but also at the free-throw line. She is one of nine players nationally that qualifies with a 100% shooting mark from the free-throw line (10-of-10).

THE SERIES AGAINST SNU

SNU leads the all-time series 35-13, which dates back to the 1993 season. The two squads met last season in Lubbock, resulting in a 65-40 LCU win (Nov. 16, 2018). Prior to that meeting, LCU had not met since Mar. 2, 2012, which was their last season in which the two squads were conference foes in the NAIA's Sooner Athletic Conference. LCU has won five of the prior seven meetings.

PREVIOUS RECAP VS. SNU

Nov. 16, 2018 (Lubbock, Texas) – LCU:65 - SNU:40

Olivia Robertson recorded her first career double-double with 15 points and a career-tying 10 rebounds to help lead No.3/10 Lubbock Christian University to a 65-40 victory over Southern Nazarene University Friday evening inside Rip Griffin Center.

The Lady Chaps and Crimson Storm exchanged the lead five times in the opening quarter of play, but LCU first had to overcome a 5-0 deficit after SNU jumped on the scoreboard first. LCU's Maddi Chitsey closed the first quarter with a layup to close the quarter with LCU leading 16-15. LCU outscored SNU 16-5 in the second quarter, with the breathing room mounting off an 11-0 run to provide LCU a 32-20 halftime lead. Kailin Davis led LCU with 10 points in the first half, with eight tallied in the second quarter.

LCU continued to extend on their lead in the second half. Madelyn Turner provided six points in the quarter and LCU extended their lead to 48-28 before heading into the fourth quarter with LCU ahead 48-33.

While SNU was shooting a miserable 11.1% (1-of-9) in the fourth quarter, the Lady Chaps continued to pull away. LCU was 7-of-12 in the quarter and Robertson clinched her double-double with six points and three rebounds in the quarter. LCU outscored SNU 17-7 in the frame and led as much as 65-35 (1:49 remaining in the contest).

LCU held SNU to a 27.7% (13/47) shooting mark, while going 46% (23/50) on their offensive end. The two teams combined for 37 turnovers, with 20 by LCU, but LCU was still able to outscore the Crimson Storm 15-11 in points off turnovers. The Lady Chaps, who had a 28-14 scoring advantage in the paint, received 10 points in the game from Davis, who joined Robertson in double figures for LCU. Robertson's 10 rebounds led the squad which had a 38-22 rebound advantage over SNU.

FIVE THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT UCO

1 > The Bronchos are coming off a 19-12 overall record from last season. They had a 9-10 mark in Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) play, resulting in a seventh-place finish in conference.

2 > The MIAA coaches media members (two separate polls) picked the Bronchos seventh in the conference in each of their preseason polls.

3 > UCO opens their stay in San Antonio Friday facing St. Mary's University. The Bronchos match against LCU will mark their third contest of the week. UCO defeated Harding Tuesday 87-74.

4 > The Bronchos possess a scoring offense that ranks ninth nationally with a pace of 86.3 points per game.

5 > Shatoya Byrson ranks 35th in the nation in steals with 18, collecting 3.0 per game (40th nationally). UCO averages 11.8 steals and 22.2 turnovers forced per game.

THE SERIES AGAINST UCO

The Lady Chaps and Bronchos have only met one prior time, with the prior meeting resulting in a 78-70 UCO victory on Dec. 2, 2000. The lone prior meeting was a neutral site game in Lawton, Okla., when UCO was a member of the Lone Star Conference (LCU was a NAIA member).

In 10 seasons at the helm while an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons at the helm, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the results have not changed since transitioning. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season. That led to a remarkable 2015-2016 season. A season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually a NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2015-16 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

In 16 seasons at LCU (the 2019-20 season marks his 17th), Gomez enters the 2019-2020 season with a 397-122 collegiate coaching record. He also enters his squad into Lone Star Conference play for the first time. He completed Heartland Conference play with a 118-17 (.874) overall record.

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific.

LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University.

In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU.

LCU had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded.

In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 29 years, and the couple has two children: Hayden and Landon.



VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011.



KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She played an integral role in the coaching staff when the Lady Chaps went on to win the NCAA Div. II National Championship in the 2015-16 season. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

Ashton Duncan took advantage of her first career start and notched a career-high 24 points to help No.1 Lubbock Christian University avoid a monstrous Angelo State comeback attempt and claim a 75-64 victory in their Lone Star Conference opener Saturday afternoon inside Junell Center.

Duncan, a junior appearing in her 54th career game with the Lady Chaps, nailed eight of her first nine shot attempts during the game, including her first five field goal attempts. She posted 13 points in the first half off 5-of-6 shooting and was key in the Lady Chaps exploding offensively early. After missing their first four shot attempts, Duncan hit a three-pointer, which was the first of an eventual five consecutive Lady Chap successful field goal attempts over a stretch in which LCU was 9-of-11 from the field (bookended by Duncan three-pointers) to give them a 23-15 lead. LCU had a 16-0 scoring run, which included LCU closing the first quarter on a 7-0 run for a 23-15 lead before opening the second quarter on a 9-0 run for a 32-15 advantage. Duncan had 10 of the 16 points during the run, while ASU missed nine consecutive field goal attempts over nearly a seven-minute stretch. Along with Duncan's production, the Lady Chaps also received 12 points from Maddi Chitsey in the half, which helped LCU take a 42-29 lead into the half.

In the second half, the hot-hand for Duncan continued. She made four consecutive LCU field goals (nine points), as LCU went on a 10-0 run and built their lead to 56-33 with four minutes into the third quarter. With the 23-point advantage, it was not time to relax for the Lady Chaps, who had to put up with a surge by the Belles. Angelo State responded with three-pointers from Lana Marov and Sawyer Lloyd, which led to a 16-2 run to close the third quarter with LCU's lead cut to 58-49.

The Belles chipped away at the LCU lead and were able to trim the lead to 68-63 on a three-point play by De'anira Moore with 5:29 remaining. LCU erased any further meltdown thoughts with a 5-0 run to push the lead back to double figures (73-63).

LCU took advantage of turnovers early in the game, forcing the Belles into 11 turnovers and outscoring ASU 13-2 in points-off-turnovers. They finished the game with a 22-14 advantage in points off turnovers and a 21-14 turnover advantage.

The Lady Chaps shot 47.5% (29/61) from the field and knocked down nine three-pointers. They held ASU to 33.9% (21/62) shooting from the field. Duncan led all scorers with 24 points off 10-of-16 shooting, with a 4-of-9 mark from outside. Allie Schulte, who posted 13 points in the second half, finished with 18 points off 8-of-16 shooting.

ASU was led by Moore, who had 21 points. Catara Samuel (15), Marov (14) and Lloyd (12) also finished in double figures for the Belles, who fell to 2-2 overall and 0-1 in conference. Lloyd (2-of-6) and Marov (4-of-7) combined to go 6-of-13 from long range, while the rest of the Belles were 1-of-12 from three-point range.

The win for the Lady Chaps marked their seventh consecutive win over the Belles in the all-time series (LCU is 11-3 all-time against ASU) and they improved to 5-1 all-time in San Angelo in the series. LCU was playing in their first game in San Angelo since Nov. 24, 2014.

TURNING POINT

Allie Schulte played a pivotal role for a second consecutive game during clutch time. Schulte put an end to the 16-2 ASU run in the fourth quarter with five straight LCU points, including a three-pointer to help her finish 2-of-4 in the game from downtown. Schulte had seven points in the fourth quarter and was 3-of-3 from the field in the quarter (she was 6-of-9 from the field in the second half). Her and the Lady Chaps defense helped ASU end the game missing their final eight field goal attempts and going scoreless over the game's final 2:27.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

The Lady Chaps are 5-0 overall and their win Saturday, in their first-ever Lone Star Conference contest, places them 1-0 in conference play. Under the coaching guidance of Steve Gomez, LCU is 15-2 in conference openers. They have won 14 of their last 15 conference openers and are 6-1 in conference openers since leaving the NAIA.
