#### RING IT ON!

No.1 Lubbock Christian University returns home to Rip Griffin Center Thursday, hosting Texas Woman's at 5:30 p.m. for their Lone Star Conference home opener. Members of the Lady Chaparrals 2019 NCAA Division II women's basketball national championship squad will be awarded their championship rings in a ceremony to be conducted during halftime of the men's game, which follows the Lady Chaps game Thursday. The Lady Chaps are 7-0 on the season and their matchup against Texas Woman's places a pair of 1-0 LSC squads going head-to-head. Toss in LCU's three exhibition games, and the Lady Chaps have played eight of their ten games away from home. LCU just completed a four-game stretch in which all four teams were either nationally ranked or were receiving votes in national top-25 polls. Three of the games were away from home, as LCU's last home game was Nov. 16 against No.20 Southwestern Oklahoma State.

#### WALK THE LINE

LCU completed their third consecutive stay at the St. Mary's Thanksgiving Classic in San Antonio,

Texas and they went 2-0 for the first time at the event behind the play of Caitlyn Cunyus and Allie Schulte. At 5-6, Cunyus is the smallest player on the floor, but it did not stop her in matching career highs in consecutive performances, grabbing nine rebounds in a win over Southern Nazarene and Central Oklahoma. LCU overcame halftime deficits in each game, and in overtime against UCO, it was key rebounds leading to her being fouled and earning the win going 6-of-6 from the free-throw line in the overtime frame. She went 9-of-9 from the line against UCO (13-of-13 on the week), which was the highest single-game mark by a Lady Chap since Nicole Hampton was 14-of-14 in a contest during the 2013-14 season. Cunyus also contributed scoring averages of 12.0 points a game on the week, capped by her 17-point nine-rebound performance against UCO. She also contributed six assists and a steal on the week.

Schulte led LCU in San Antonio with 14.5-point scoring average in the pair of games. She averaged 12 points a contest in the second half alone, as her performance helped LCU produce wins over Southern Nazarene and Central Oklahoma, who

were a combined 10-1 going into the games. Schulte posted 14 points and a career-high nine rebounds against SNU, and followed with 15 points against UCO. She went 8-of-8 from the free-throw line against SNU and finished the week 10-of-12 from the line. Schulte also averaged 2.5 assists and contributed three steals and a pair of blocks.

#### LONE STAR DEBUT

Playing conference games in December is not out of the norm, but playing a conference match in November was a little different, although expected with LCU playing in their first season in the 18-team Lone Star Conference. On Nov. 23, LCU defeated Angelo State 75-64 and it was LCU's first conference game in November since hosting Oklahoma Panhandle State (Nov. 21, 2013) and Newman (Nov. 23, 2013) during the 2013-14 season. LCU's LSC opener was their 27th conference opener and their first in the LSC after six

Heartland Conference and 19 Sooner Athletic Conference openers. The Lady Chaps went 11-8 all-time in SAC openers and 5-1 in HC openers, with a loss at St. Mary's (Dec. 31, 2016) marking their only loss in a Heartland Conference opener. The win over ASU improved LCU to 15-2 all-time in conference openers under head coach Steve Gomez. They have won 14 of their prior 15 consecutive conference openers. Ashton Duncan leads LCU in conference scoring, averaging 24 points a game.

### WHO IS COUNTING?

LCU's 7-0 start tops their 6-0 start to the 2017-18 season and it is their best start since their memorable 2015-16 season in which they went 35-0. LCU is one of two unbeaten teams in the LSC and there are 22 unbeaten teams in Division II.

### 1,000-POINT CLUB

Last Friday in San Antonio, Texas, Maddi Chitsey became the only active Lady Chap to reach 1,000-career points. She posted 12 points against Southern Nazarene to surpass 1,000 career points and enters this week's contest with 1,024 points in 92 career games. Chitsey is the latest player to reach the 1,000-point mark as a Lady Chap since Olivia Robertson completed the task in March last season.

### RELAX

Despite posted a 7-0 record, the Lady Chaps can't say they have not faced adversity. LCU has overcome a deficit in each game this season, with a 10-point deficit Friday against Southern Nazarene marking their biggest deficit of the season. LCU is 2-0 this season when trailing at the half and 2-0 when trailing after three quarters. LCU went 7-3 last season when trailing at the half and 1-3 in contests they trailed after three quarters.

### WHEN AT HOME

LCU went 15-0 last season inside Rip Griffin Center. With LCU's win 71-61 on Nov. 16 over No.20 Southwestern Oklahoma State, LCU extended their active home win streak to 67 games, which ranks third all-time in NCAA Division II women's basketball (it actively leads NCAA Div. II). The record is 87 consecutive home victories by Nebraska-Kearney, who completed the task from Jan. 31, 1995 - Nov. 24, 2001. LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix, has also won 55 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland

Conference home games.

### MORE ON THE HOME FRONT

LCU is 2-0 at home this season. Maddi Chitsey leads LCU averaging 18.0 points at home, with Ashton Duncan and Laynee Burr each averaging 11.5 points a home contest to assist in the scoring. LCU is shooting 44.5% at home this season.

### NATIONALLY KNOWN

Based on the preseason rankings for the 2019-20 season (D2SIDA, WBCA along with Lone Star Conference), the Lady Chaparrals carry the highest expectations in program history to start a season. D2SIDA placed the defending national champions No.1 and the WBCA ranked LCU No.2 despite the Lady Chaps receiving 14 of the 23 first place votes. Each ranking is their highest preseason ranking in program history. The LSC preseason ranked LCU No.1 in their preseason rankings. The third national in-season rankings came out this week and LCU remained No.1 in the WBCA and No.2 in D2SIDA polls.

### BLOCK PARTIES ARE BACK

LCU ranks 13th nationally in blocks (37) and 13th in blocks per game (5.3). Maddi Chitsey leads the team with 16 blocks (second in the conference and tied for 13th nationally), at a pace of 2.3 per game (second in the conference and 18th nationally). The season mark for Chitsey has her with 107 career blocks, which places her fifth all-time in program history. LCU has ranked in the top-10 nationally in blocks each season since the 2015-16 season, which was their first season eligible to have statistics included among NCAA leaders. They ranked 10th in total blocks last season (155), second in 2017-18 (202, ranking fourth with a pace of 6.1 per game), fourth in 2016-17 (170, leading the nation with 5.7 per game) and led NCAA Division II in 2015-16 with 235 blocks (6.7 per game).

### CHARITY WORK

LCU are 28-of-34 (82.4%) from the free-throw line at home, which includes Madelyn Turner (8-of-8) and Maddi Chitsey (6-of-6) combining for a 14-of-14 mark from the line at home. The Lady Chaps were 38-of-50 in San Antonio (76%) and are shooting 78.0% from the line this season, which has them ranking second in the LSC in free-throw percentage (ranking 20th nationally). In each season LCU has been eligible to have team statistics included among NCAA Division II leaders (2015-15), the Lady Chaps have finished in the top-three in their conference in free-throw shooting. They led the Heartland Conference in 2017-18 with a 76.2% mark from the line, ranking 33rd nationally. Their highest national ranking is 32nd (75.0%) from the 2015-16 season. Caitlyn Cunyus leads LCU and ranks third in the LSC and 28th nationally with a 91.3% shooting mark from the line (Turner does not qualify with enough attempts but is shooting 92.9% from the line). There are two qualified players with a 100% shooting mark from the free-throw line in NCAA Division II.

### BE DEFENSIVE

The Lady Chaps lead the LSC and rank seventh nationally, holding opponents to a 31.6% shooting mark on the season. Of their seven contests, LCU has held the opponent to under a 30% shooting mark three times and the highest shooting percentage they have allowed in a game was 36.8% by Metro State (Nov. 9).

### D-NOTES

The Lady Chaps lead the LSC in defensive rebounds a game with a mark of 30.1 per contest, which ranks 27th nationally. Their team leader in defensive rebounds per game is Caitlyn Cunyus, who ranks fourth in the LSC with 5.6 per contest.

### FIVE THINGS ABOUT TWU

**1 >** The Pioneers are 3-2 this season and have not played since a 61-42 loss at East Central on Nov. 27. They are coming off a 10-19 campaign in 2018-19, finishing seventh in the LSC with a 7-13 record. They went 3-8 last season in road play.

**2 >** TWU is preseason picked 10th in the LSC Preseason Poll. The Pioneers are 1-0 so far in LSC play after an impressive 63-55 road win at Tarleton State (Nov. 23).

**3 >** Like LCU, TWU possesses a gritty defense. The Pioneers rank second in the conference (behind LCU), holding opponents to a 33.1% shooting mark from the field (19th nationally). They have held opponents to a 54.4-point scoring average (third in the LSC).

**4 >** Carissa Moody, who has 15 career double-doubles, leads the LSC and ranks seventh nationally with 8.6 rebounds per game. Her overall average of 10.8 rebounds leads the LSC and is 24th nationally.

**5 >** TWU opponents have shot 127 three-point attempts, which is 47 more than the Pioneers.

### THE SERIES AGAINST TWU

LCU has won the prior three meetings over TWU and has a 4-1 series advantage. Four of the meetings have come since the 2010-2011 season. The two teams had never met in Lubbock until their prior meeting, which was LCU's first-ever NCAA postseason contest and resulted in a 95-75 victory by LCU on Mar. 10, 2016.

### PREVIOUS RECAP VS. TWU

**Mar. 10, 2016 (Lubbock, Texas) – LCU:95 - TWU:75**

An 18-point first half from Haley Fowler and a 57.6% shooting percentage by top-seeded Lubbock Christian University against the ninth-toughest defense (opposing shooting percentage) in NCAA Division II led the Lady Chaparrals to a 95-75 in over eighth-seeded Texas Woman's University in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament and the South Central Region.

Texas Woman's came out with a strong balanced first quarter, with six different players getting field goals. A three-pointer by Kenesha Saygo was one of three three-pointers the Pioneers connected on out of their first five field goal attempts and it gave TWU an 8-2 lead early. They never trailed until Fowler's layup with 2:08 remaining for a 16-15 LCU lead. The field goal for Fowler was one of five in the quarter for the senior who had 13 points in the quarter. With a little over a minute to go in the quarter, TWU went a span of four minutes (carrying over into the second quarter) without a field goal, while LCU went on a 10-0 run. It was part of an overall 16-2 run by LCU, who led 33-20 with 5:19 left in the first half at the close of the run. LCU outscored TWU 29-10 in the second quarter. TWU, who shot 50% in the first half, was held to 3-of-20 (15%) shooting from the field in the second quarter. LCU, with 18 points in the half from Fowler and 10 points from Tess Bruffey, led 50-28 at the half. LCU had a 30-12 scoring advantage in the paint in the half.

LCU was 11-of-17 (64.7%) from the field in the third quarter. Bailey Haist, with five points in the quarter, connected on a three-pointer for a 70-42 lead with two minutes remaining in the quarter for LCU's largest lead of the game. TWU closed the quarter on a 6-0 run to cut LCU's lead to 72-50 heading into the fourth quarter. LCU's bench saw much of the floor in the fourth quarter, scoring 14 of their 23 points in the quarter. The Lady Chaps never let their lead slip under a 20-point lead despite Danielle Westerfield scoring seven of her 13 points in the quarter for TWU.

Nicole Hampton had a solid game for LCU, scoring 18 points and also adding nine rebounds, seven assists and five steals. Fowler finished 8-of-10 from the field and had a season high 22 points. Five Lady Chaps finished with double figures in points, with Kelsey Hoppel scoring 10 points and Tess Bruffey and Blair Taylor scoring 11 points each. Taylor was 5-of-6 from the field with her season high point totals tallied in an 11-minute span.

LCU finished the game 57.6% (34/59) from the field and they were 44.4% (8/18) from long range. The 95 points was the most allowed this season by TWU, who was without Erin Maxwell (Lone Star Conference Defensive Player of the Year). TWU received 20 points from Saygo in the loss.

In 10 seasons at the helm while an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons at the helm, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the results have not changed since transitioning. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season. That led to a remarkable 2015-2016 season. A season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually a NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2015-16 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

In 16 seasons at LCU (the 2019-20 season marks his 17th), Gomez enters the 2019-2020 season with a 397-122 collegiate coaching record. He also enters his squad into Lone Star Conference play for the first time. He completed Heartland Conference play with a 118-17 (.874) overall record.

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific.

LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University.

In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU.

LCU had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded.

In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 29 years, and the couple has two children: Hayden and Landon.



### VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011.



### KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She played an integral role in the coaching staff when the Lady Chaps went on to win the NCAA Div. II National Championship in the 2015-16 season. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

## LAST TIME OUT: Yes They Cun-yus!... Lady Chaps Win in OT

Caitlyn Cunyus Sinks 9-of-9 Free-Throws To Help LCU Outlast Bronchos

Caitlyn Cunyus went 6-of-6 from the free-throw line in overtime to cap a 17-point and nine-rebound performance to help No.1 Lubbock Christian University survive with a 68-63 overtime victory over Central Oklahoma Saturday afternoon in their final game of the St. Mary's Thanksgiving Classic inside Bill Greehey Arena.

LCU would have been disappointed with a loss after leading for nearly 32 minutes (31:45) of the game, while trailing in less than six minutes of the contest. The game was decided from the free-throw line, as LCU went the final 3:28 of the fourth quarter without a field goal and went 2-of-4 in the final 3:27 from the line, while UCO went 3-of-4 from the line in the final 41 seconds to force overtime. UCO was without a field goal in the final 2:19 after bouncing back from a 57-52 deficit (from a 6-0 LCU run involving points all from Cunyus) with a pair of field goals to cut the LCU lead to 57-56 with 2:19 left.

UCO missed their final three field goal attempts in regulation in the final 2:19, while LCU was unsuccessful on two attempts in regulation over a span of 3:27 (all five shots to close the half by the combined two squads were all three-point attempts). Tied 59-59 in overtime, UCO won the tip and worked the ball inside to Kelsey Johnson, who scored on an and-one play resulting in LCU's Maddi Chitsey fouling out. At the time (26 seconds into overtime), Chitsey was leading LCU with 14 points. Johnson made the free-throw attempt and put the Bronchos up 62-59.

The Bronchos would go the final 4:34 of overtime without a field goal and scoring one point from the free-throw line. LCU had to climb from the three-point deficit with Ashton Duncan scoring their only field goal of overtime followed by a 7-of-8 performance from the free-throw line. Cunyus, who went 9-of-9 from the line in the game, was 6-of-6 from the line in overtime. Neither team had a field goal in the final 4:14 of the overtime/game.

Central Oklahoma's shooting dried up late. They missed their final seven field goal attempts and made one of their last 11 attempts. Heading into the fourth quarter, with the score tied 45-45, UCO went the final 15 minutes of the game 5-of-21 (23.8%) from the field. The Bronchos entered the fourth quarter 7-of-14 (50%) from three-point range (40% of their offense to that point had been produced from long range field goals), but they closed the game's final 15 minutes 0-of-10.

LCU's shooting depended on the score. While holding UCO to 32.4% (12/71) from field, LCU was 43.4% (23/53) shooting in the contest. Broken down, LCU was 4-of-15 (26.7%) from the field with seven turnovers during possessions in which they had a one-possession lead (lead of 1-3 points), but they were 10-of-17 shooting (58.9%) when the game was either tied or they trailed.

The lead changed hands nine times, but the first lead change did not take place until Johnson's jumper with 45 seconds in the first half sparked a 5-2 UCO run to end the half with a 30-27 lead over the Lady Chaps. LCU never trailed by more than three points, but let a nine-point lead in the second quarter, a four-point lead in the third quarter and a five-point lead in the fourth quarter slip away.

LCU closed the game on a 9-1 run with seven of the points from the line. They finished the game 17-of-22 (77.3%) from the line. Five different players went to the charity stripe for LCU and none of the five players missed more than two attempts. LCU had a 17-10 scoring advantage at the free-throw line in the game.

Cunyus' 17 points led all scorers. Allie Schulte (15 points) and Chitsey (14 points) also helped out offensively for LCU. The pair each had 10 points after the half. Cunyus matched a career high with nine rebounds for a third time, and all three times have occurred in a four-game span. LCU had a 7-0 advantage in blocks in the game, with Emma Middleton and Chitsey each recorded three blocks.

UCO, remaining without a regulation loss (6-2 on the season), received a double-double by Johnson in the loss. She had 16 points and 11 rebounds. McKenna Pulley finished with 11 points off the bench to aid the Bronchos offense.

The win was LCU's first-ever win over UCO. The two programs were meeting for just the second time all-time, and the first since Dec. 2, 2000. LCU completed their stay in San Antonio going 2-0 for the first time in the St. Mary's Thanksgiving Classic (third consecutive year participating in the tournament. LCU's 7-0 start is their best start since their 35-0 2015-16 national championship season.

## TURNING POINT

UCO had a golden opportunity in the final 30 seconds, trailing 64-63, as McKenna Pulley had an open look from the right-elbow and 27 seconds remaining. Her shot did not fall and Emma Middleton, who has a +7 on the plus/minus in overtime, grabbed her third rebound in overtime. Cunyus then sealed the win with free-throws, as she was 6-of-6 in pressure-filled free-throws in overtime. One game after Allie Schulte became the eighth Lady Chap to go 8-of-8 from the line since Jan. 16, 2014, Cunyus became the first Lady Chap to go 9-of-9 from the line since former Lady Chap Nicole Hampton's 14-of-14 performance from the line on Jan. 16, 2014.

## INSIDE THE NUMBERS

UCO outscored LCU 11-9 in second-chance scoring. A number that could have been much higher for UCO, as they produced 15 offensive rebounds. The Bronchos did take advantage of an 18-12 turnover advantage, which led to a 17-6 UCO scoring advantage. Combining the turnovers with the offensive boards, UCO had 18 more field goal attempts than LCU. That is the biggest margin by an LCU opponent since Arkansas Fort Smith had a 63-45 advantage in attempts against LCU on Mar. 4, 2018. Ironically UCO's Micayla Haynes, a UAFA transfer, played in both contests.
