STEALING THE SHOW

LCU enters the week ranked 58th in NCAA Division II in steals (48) and is 14th in steals per game (12.0). The Lady Chaps had 17 steals on Jan. 3 at UTT, for their highest total since 17 on January 10, 2019, and it placed LCU with at least 10 steals in three consecutive games for the first time since February of 2019. If LCU can extend it to four consecutive games, it would be the first time LCU has completed the task since they had six straight games of at

least 10 steals in February of 2016. Allie Schulte leads the team in steals (9) and averages 2.25 per game to rank ninth in the LSC

LONG DISTANCE CALLS

LCU was 12-of-35 on Jan. 3 from three-point range (34.3%) in Tyler. Allie Schulte was 6-of-7 from threepoint range, while the rest of the team combined to go 6-of-28 (21.4%). The 35 three-point attempts was LCU's highest mark since Mar. 11, 2016 (37 attempts vs. Angelo State). LCU ranks 23rd nationally with a conference-leading 47 three-pointers, ranking second nationally with 11.8 per game. The Lady Chaps success rate of 41.2% shooting from outside is 11th nationally. Ashton Duncan leads LCU with 14 threepointers (46th nationally and is second in the LSC), ranking 11th nationally with a conference-best rate of 3.5 per game. Schulte ranks third nationally and leads the conference with a shooting percentage of 69.2%, and Duncan ranks fourth in the conference at 42.4%. Eleven (11) different Lady Chaps have at least one three-pointer on the season.

2020 IS IN THE BOOKS

The 2020 calendar year was a good one for the Lady Chaps (pushing COVID-19 matters aside). In the year Lady Chaps went 19-3 (86.4%) in games played during the 2020 calendar year. LCU had a 22-1 (95.7%) record for all games played in 2020, and they went 29-5 (85.3%) in 2019, 26-5 (83.9%) in 2017, 29-10 (74.4%) in 2016 and 24-4 (85.7%) in 2015.

THROWING STONES

A look at upcoming milestones on the horizon for Lady Chap members:

-Allie Schulte needs 74 points to reach 1000 career points.

-She ranks third nationally in Division II active players in career games played with 104.

-Ashton Duncan needs a point to reach 500 career points.

-She needs 19 three-pointers to reach 150 career three-pointers.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

Only one of the two national associations conducting national top-25 preseason polls for NCAA Division II women's basketball conducted a preseason poll this season. D2SIDA conducted a preseason poll, and has Lubbock Christian University as the Preseason No.3 ranked program entering the 2020-2021 season. The first in-season D2SIDA poll was released this week, with LCU remaining No.3 nationally. The WBCA Top-25 Poll is scheduled to begin this month.

LCU has found their way into the D2SIDA preseason poll seven consecutive seasons, marking every season they have been eligible to appear (due to the transfer from NAIA to NCAA Div. II), ranking No.1 (2019-20), No.3 (2018-19), No.23 (2017-18), No. 4 (2016-17), No.15 (2015-16) and receiving votes in 2014-15. The Lady Chaps received one of the 16 first-place votes, and was the only school other that preseason favorite, Drury, to receive a first-place vote.

LCU, the preseason Lone Star Conference favorites, was the top team slated in the South Central Region D2SIDA Top-10 rankings, and the only program nationally to receive all six firstplace votes from within their own region.

KEEP IN MIND

The Lone Star Conference announced it will use a point rating system to determine its men's and women's basketball standings this year due to COVID-19 related schedule adjustments.

The point rating system will replace winning percentage for the LSC's basketball conference standings, divisional standings and conference tournament seeding in 2020-21.

The system assigns a numerical value to game results depending on the site and quality of the opponent. Teams will earn more points for a win on the road or at home against top competition based on conference winning percentage and receive fewer points for a win against lesser opposition. Points are also dispersed for losses, with more points awarded for a loss against stronger competition.

Each week, the team ratings will be determined by taking the total points divided by league games played with the opponents winning percentage updated throughout the year.

The LSC will publish the point rating system rankings in mid-January and post weekly updates for the rest of the season.

The change will help offset an unbalanced league Schedule and games canceled due to COVID-19. Typically, the LSC slate includes games against all other league teams but this year is using a modified "bubble" schedule format to enhance studentathlete safety with regard to COVID-19 and reduce the amount of contact amongst teams by playing the same opponent twice during the week.

The conference tournament will consist of the top eight men's and women's teams with first-round games on-campus on Tuesday, March 2 followed by the four winning teams advancing to the final site at the highest remaining seed on Friday, March 5 and Saturday, March 6.

LSC POINT RATING SYSTEM

COVID AND VIEWING OPTIONS

LCU opens the week in San Angelo, where capacity at the Junell Center (6,500) will be limited to 50%.

COVID-19 regulations by LCU will have the Rip Griffin Center at 50% capacity. All home game ticket and spectator policies are subject to change on a gameby-game basis. For games allowing fans, a limited number of tickets are available (admission covers both men's and women's games on that date) to the general public on www.lcuchaps.com/tickets.

Each game will be broadcast on the LSC Digital Network as an option for fans unable to attend. The Lone Star Conference have a new hybrid pricing model for the LSC Digital Network this season. The broadcasts of volleyball and men's and women's basketball games will be available via pay-per-view (PPV) conference-wide under the new model. Fans can

The LSC Digital Network is in its second year showcasing the academic and athletic events of the league and its 18 member institutions. Fans can watch games and purchase passes online at www.lonestarconferencenetwork.com or www. lcuchaps.com/live on computer and mobile devices. Viewers can also tune in to games on the LSC Digital Network via OTT apps available on Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV, Android TV and Roku by searching for "LSC Digital Network."

WHEN AT HOME

LCU went 13-0 last season inside Rip Griffin Center. They enter Saturday's play with their active home win streak sitting at 80 games, which ranks third all-time in NCAA Division II women's basketball (it actively leads all of NCAA). The record is 87 consecutive home victories by Ne-Jan. 31, 1995 - Nov. 24, 2001. LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix, has also won 68 consecutive home conference

games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games (they are 15-0 in LSC home games).

MORE ON THE HOME FRONT

Ashton Duncan leads LCU at home this season, averaging 17 points per game. Allie Schulte also averages double figures at home, with an average of 13.0 points per home contest. LCU has a 13-1 advantage in blocks at home and they have held opponents to 31.7% shooting. The Lady Chaps are shooting 51.3% on the Rip Griffin Center floor this season, with a 48% shooting mark from outside.

BLOCKS ARE BACK

Since their first season as official NCAA Division II members (2015-16), LCU has ranked at least 12th or better in total blocks (led the nation in 15-16 and ranked second in 17-18) in each season of play and have ranked in the top-14 in four of the five seasons in blocks per game (led the nation in 15-16 and 16-17). This sons in blocks per game (led the nation in 15-16 and 16-17). This season, LCU looks as if they may keep the trend continuing. They currently rank 16th in blocks (26) and are fourth in blocks per game (6.5), ranking second in the LSC in each category. Emma Middleton (7, fifth in the conference and 44th nationally), Whitney Cox and Juliana Robertson (6, tied for eighth in the conference) place LCU with three players in the top-10 in the LSC in blocks. Middleton also ranks fifth in the LSC and 33rd nationally with 1.75 blocks per game blocks per game.

DISTRIBUTION

With a mark of 1.46, LCU ranks sixth in the nation in assist/turn- won nine consecutive meetings. over ratio. LCU's 21.5 assists per game leads the nation, with team leader Juliana Robertson averaging 4.2 per game to rank 58th nationally and third in the conference. Allie Schulte is not far behind, ranking fifth in the conference with a mark of 3.8 per game. Channing Cunyus (2.3) and Ashton Duncan (2.2) are also averaging over 2.0 assists per game. LCU ranks 46th nationally in LCU r game (they rank 19th in turnovers forced and 11th in turnover margin).

LAST LINE OF DEFENSE

Along with ranking 10th nationally in steals per game, LCU's defense is holding opponents to 43.2 points per game (ranks third Lubbock Christian University to a 91-65 Quarterfinals victory over nationally). From the floor, opponents are shooting 30.0% (fifth nationally) and 28% from three-point range (37th nationally).

VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at East-ern New Mexico University. His

first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011.

In 10 seasons at the helm while an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons at the helm, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the results have not changed since transitioning. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season. That led to an astounding 2015-2016 season. A season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No.1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 23-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually a NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo. Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo

> 2015-16 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the champion-ship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to Snip squad. Despite the resolutioning, LCO Snil Weith 19-11 overall and 12-4 in Contenence, in Toute to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D, ending their season with a 31-2 record

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU

made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

LCU's title defense was rudely interrupted by the COVID Pandemic in 2019-20. LCU was 28-3 and claimed the Lone Star Conference Championship during their first season in the conference. LCU was chosen to host the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals for a third time, but the COVID shutdown halted the remainder of the season less than 24 hours prior to the first tournament game

In 17 seasons at LCU (the 2020-21 season marks his 18th), Gomez enters the 2020-2021 season with a 425-125 collegiate coaching record. The 2020-21 season marks LCU's eighth since leaving the NAIA and LCU is 191-29 in that span (86.8%).

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific.

LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University

In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU.

LCU had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded.

In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament. Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She played an integral role in the coaching staff when the Lady Chaps went on to win the NCAA Div. II National Championship in the 2015-16 season. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No.45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No.55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball mier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

LAST TIME OUT: Schulte Has Career Outing Outside, as Lady Chaps Complete Patriot Sweep

LCU Swiped 17 Steals in Their First Regular Season Sunday-Game Since Making the Move to NCAA



Allie Schulte set a career high in three-pointers, with a 6-of-7 long-range shooting performance, and No.3 Lubbock Christian University used 17 steals to outscore UT Tyler 29-10 in points-off-turnovers and surged past the Patriots 69-48, which completed a Lone Star Conference regular season series sweep inside Patriot Center.

Schulte had the hot-hand early, as she hit three three-pointers in the opening three minutes of the game. LCU opened Saturday's game with an 11-0 run and duplicated the task Sunday, with Schulte's trio of treys part of the run. Emma Middleton stole the spotlight for a 60-second scoring outburst, scoring six points and putting LCU up 17-2 midway through the first quarter. Madelyn Turner and Channing Cunyus each added a three-pointer and LCU completed the opening frame with five three-pointers for a 27-8 lead. Schulte opened LCU's second quarter scoring with her fourth three-pointer of the game, but the bucket would not foreshadow to an offensive quarter

for the Lady Chaps. UTT went on an 8-3 run and cut LCU's lead to 35-16. LCU was held to three field goals in the quarter. The first two were Schulte three-pointers (she had five three-pointers in the first half) and made 3:39 apart. LCU led 35-18 at the half.

The Lady Chaps scored 36 points from long range off 12 three-pointers in the game (they had 26 points from the field inside the arc). Along with the five three-pointers in the opening quarter, the Lady Chaps found success in the third quarter, started by Ashton Duncan connecting 1:14 into the half. Schulte hit her career-high three-pointer midway in the third quarter and Juliana Robertson dialed in from long range two minutes later, as LCU had three three-pointers in the quarter. The outside success led to LCU leading 56-31 through three quarters.

Eight bench players occupied time in the fourth quarter, and Middleton was the only starting member to receive minutes in the quarter. Audrey Robertson hit a three-pointer two minutes into the final frame for a 62-33 LCU lead and their largest lead of the game.

UTT, shooting under 18% from the field Saturday, improved their shooting Sunday, shooting 38% (19/50) from the field. They shot 46.2% in the third and fourth quarter, going on a 7-0 and 5-0 run late in the game to outscore LCU 15-9 in the game's final 7:33 of play.

Schulte was LCU's lone double-figure point producer. She was 7-of-9 from the field and 6-of-7 from "three-point land." She also led LCU with five rebounds. Juliana Robertson did not surpass double figures in any offensive categories, but had a balanced productive game. She was 4-of-6 from the field, with nine points, and also had three steals, three assists, two blocks and forced three fouls against the Pats.

LCU outscored the Patriots 29-10 in points-off-turnovers, with a majority of the points in response to a season-high 17 steals. Ten (10) different Lady Chaps had a steal, with Maci Maddox claiming a game-high four steals. The 17 steals for LCU was their highest total since 17 on January 10, 2019, and it places LCU with at least 10 steals in three consecutive games for the first time since February of 2019.

The Patriots remain winless on the season with the loss, which has them at 0-2 overall and 0-2 in conference. Shala Robinson led them in scoring with 10 points. The win was LCU's 16th consecutive win (carrying over from last season) and they are 4-0 overall and 4-0 in conference

play. LCU improved to 3-0 all-time against UT Tyler, with all three wins posted inside Patriot Center. The game marked LCU's first regular season Sunday-game since transitioning to NCAA Division II.

TURNING POINT

UTT's strong second quarter started to leak into the second half. Niah Richard connected on a three-pointer three-minutes into the third quarter and cut LCU's lead to 40-25. It turned out to be the closest UTT would get, as LCU responded with a field goal by Turner and a three-pointer by Schulte. It led to a 10-2 run to regain control of the contest.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

LCU was 12-of-35 in the game from three-point range (34.3%). Schulte was 6-of-7, while the rest of the team combined to go 6-of-28 (21.4%). The 35 three-point attempts was LCU's highest mark since Mar. 11, 2016 (37 attempts vs. Angelo State).
