BACK TO THE GRIND

Having not played since December 12, 2020, the No.3 Lubbock Christian University Lady Chaparrals finally return to action Saturday with a two-game series at UT Tyler in Tyler, Texas, marking their first road trip of the 2020-21 season. LCU (2-0) was originally scheduled to play in Oklahoma City, Okla. Dec. 18 & 19, but the series was postponed due to COVID-19 issues. The Lady Chaps face a UT Tyler squad that is seeking to open regular season play for a second time this season, as their originally scheduled season-opening series was postponed (against UT Permian Basin). UTT has played two exhibition games against NCAA Division I opponents while awaiting this weekend's set of games.

INNOCUOUS

LCU is entering the contests with UTT following a sweep of the Rattlers of St. Mary's, in a Dec. 11 & 12 series inside Rip Griffin Center. The Lady Chaps

won by final scores of 88-52 and 67-47 in the series, with Ashton Duncan averaging 17.0 points a contest, leading to Lone Star Conference Offensive Player of the Week honors.

EXPECT RARITIES

The COVID-19 pandemic will lead to many rarities this season. While some conferences do schedule conference games in consecutive dates, this season marks the first season the LSC has scheduled conference games on consecutive dates (non-divisional contests), which is fairly rare for the Lady Chaps as well. This weekend's series is not only rare because they play their second and third games all-time against UT Tyler, but the second game of the weekend set is scheduled for Sunday. LCU, whose LSC Championship Game (tournament) win over Texas A&M-Commerce in Frisco, Texas marked their only Sunday-game last season, has not played a regular season game on a Sunday since leaving the NAIA (2012-13).

ALREADY

LCU, who started last season off 14-0, are 2-0 to start off this season. They are one of six unbeaten teams in the Lone Star Conference, and one of four of the unbeaten that has played a game this season.

2020 IS IN THE BOOKS

The 2020 calendar year was a good one for the Lady Chaps (pushing COVID-19 matters aside). In the year LCU claimed their first LSC Championship title, the Lady Chaps went 19-3 (86.4%) in games played during the 2020 calendar year. LCU had a 22-1 (95.7%) record for all games played in 2020, and they went 29-5 (85.3%) in 2019, 26-5 (83.9%) in 2017, 29-10 (74.4%) in 2016 and 24-4 (85.7%) in 2015.

top-25 preseason polls for NCAA Division II women's basketball conducted a preseason poll this season. D2SIDA conducted a preseason poll, and has Lubbock Christian University as the Preseason No.3 ranked program entering the 2020-2021 season. The WBCA Top-25 Poll will begin polling next week.

LCU has found their way into the D2SIDA preseason poll seven consecutive seasons, marking every season they have been eligible to appear (due to the transfer from NAIA to NCAA Div. II), ranking No.1 (2019-20), No.3 (2018-19), No.23 (2017-18), No. 4 (2016-17), No.15 (2015-16) and receiving votes in 2014-15. The Lady Chaps received one of the 16 first-place votes, and was the only school other than preseason favorite, Drury, to receive a first-place vote.

The D2SIDA polls are voted on by a committee of sports information directors at Division II member institutions nationwide. LCU, the preseason Lone Star Conference favorites, was the top team slated in the South Central Region D2SIDA Top-10 rankings, and the only program nationally to receive all six first-place votes from within their own region.

THROWING STONES

A look at upcoming milestones on the horizon for Lady Chap members:

Allie Schulte needs nine points to reach 900 career points.

Ashton Duncan needs 15 points to reach 500 career points.

GRAND OPENING

In their season opener, LCU shot 55.9% from the field against St. Mary's. The mark was LCU's best shooting performance in an opener since shooting 60.5% against Dallas Christian on Nov. 4, 2008 (2008-09 season opener).

KEEP IN MIND

The Lone Star Conference announced it will use a point rating system to determine its men's and women's basketball standings this year due to COVID-19 related schedule adjustments.

The point rating system will replace winning percentage for the LSC's basketball conference standings, divisional standings and conference tournament seeding in 2020-21.

The system assigns a numerical value to game results depending on the site and quality of the opponent. Teams will earn more points for a win on the road or at home against top competition based on conference winning percentage and receive fewer points for a win against lesser opposition. Points are also dispersed for

losses, with more points awarded for a loss against stronger competition.

Each week, the team ratings will be determined by taking the total points divided by league games played with the opponents winning percentage updated throughout the year.

The LSC will publish the point rating system rankings in mid-January and post weekly updates for the rest of the season.

The change will help offset an unbalanced league schedule and games canceled due to COVID-19. Typically, the LSC slate includes games against all other league teams but this year is using a modified "bubble" schedule format to enhance student-athlete safety with regard to COVID-19 and reduce the amount of contact amongst teams by playing the same opponent twice during the week.

The conference tournament will consist of the top eight men's and women's teams with first-round games on-campus on Tuesday, March 2 followed by the four winning teams advancing to the final site at the highest remaining seed on Friday, March 5 and Saturday, March 6.

LSC POINT RATING SYSTEM

Points shall be awarded for each conference contest played:

- 7 points – win over a .750 or better team on the road
- 6.5 points – win over a .750 or better team at home
- 6 points – win over a .500 or better team on the road
- 5 points – win over a .500 or better team at home
- 4.5 points – win over a .250 or better team on the road
- 4 points – win over a .250 team or better at home
- 3.5 points – win over an under .250 team on the road
- 3 points – win over an under .250 team at home
- 2.5 points – loss at home or on the road to a .750 or better team
- 2 points – loss to a .500 or better team at home or on the road
- 1 point – loss to a .250 or better team at home or on the road
- .5 points – loss to an under .250 team on the road
- 0 points – loss to an under .250 team at home

COVID AND VIEWING OPTIONS

UT Tyler is allowing 50% capacity to fans attending games inside Patriot Center at press time.

Each game will be broadcast on the LSC Digital Network as an option for fans unable to attend. The Lone Star Conference have a new hybrid pricing model for the LSC Digital Network this season. The broadcasts of volleyball and men's and women's basketball games will be available via pay-per-view (PPV) conference-wide under the new model. Fans can purchase a \$10 daily pass that will give them access to all LSC football, volleyball and basketball contests on the network that day, as well as access to previously aired games from the current season for 24 hours. In addition to live and archived streaming options, viewers will have the option to purchase and download games from the 2020-21 season for \$10 each. Select games of all other sports carried on the LSC Digital Network will be available free-to-view (FTV) or PPV at the discretion of the broadcasting institution. The LSC Digital Network is in its second year showcasing the academic and athletic events of the league and its 18 member institutions. puter and mobile devices. Viewers can also tune in to games on the LSC Digital Network via OTT apps available on Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV, Android TV and Roku by searching for "LSC Digital Network."

WHAT'S GOING ON AT HOME

LCU went 13-0 last season inside Rip Griffin Center. They enter Friday's play with their active home win streak sitting at 80 games, which ranks third all-time in NCAA Division II women's basketball (it actively leads all of NCAA). The record is 87 consecutive home victories by Nebraska-Kearney, who completed the task from Jan. 31, 1995 - Nov. 24, 2001. LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix, has also won 68 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games (they are 15-0 in LSC home games).

DOWNTOWN DUNCAN

Ashton Duncan is 10-of-17 (58.8%) from long-range through two games on the season. The three-pointers per game (5.0) leads all of NCAA Division II, and her 10 three-pointers on the season leads the LSC. Duncan matched a program record in the season opener (Dec. 11) with eight three-pointers in the game, which was a new Rip Griffin Center single-game record. Her prior high was six, ironically on Feb. 1, 2020 in LCU's last trip to Tyler. As a team, LCU leads the nation shooting 48% from long range, with 12.0 three-pointers per game ranking second nationally (Hawaii Pacific leads the mark averaging 15.0 per game).

GO FISH!

Four of LCU's five freshmen players made their debut in the LCU's season opener and they have combined for impressive numbers through two games on the season. Cambrie Heiman was the lone freshman that was not suited up in the opening series, but Maci Maddox, Lara Mason, Audrey Robertson and Shaylee Stovall have combined to shoot 10-of-19 (52.6%) from the field and 3-of-6 (50%) from long range. Robertson is the leading freshman scorer, averaging 4.5 points per game.

DISTRIBUTION

With a mark of 1.73, LCU leads the nation in assist/turnover ratio. LCU's 22.5 assists per game leads the nation, with team co-leaders Allie Schulte and Juliana Robertson each averaging 5.0 assists per game to rank tied for 16th nationally (tied for second in the conference). LCU ranks 16th nationally in turnovers per game with a mark of 13.0 per game.

FIVE THINGS ABOUT UTT

1 > The Patriots are coming off a 3-23 season in 2019-20, finishing 1-21 in the Lone Star Conference. They closed the season falling in their final 13 consecutive games of the season.
 2 > UT Tyler is preseason picked 15th in the LSC Preseason Poll. This season, they are in the South Division, which has St. Edward's Texas A&M International, Texas A&M – Kingsville, and St. Mary's joining UTT.
 3 > UTT has gone 0-2 in their exhibition schedule this season, as they fell 81-26 to Abilene Christian (Dec. 15) and 85-43 to Stephen F. Austin (Dec. 19).
 4 > Josephine Elliot led the Pats against Stephen F. Austin with 12 points. She is one of six true freshmen on the UTT roster.
 5 > This season marks UTT's final season of their transition period, moving from Division III to Division II. This is their second season in Division II and the LSC.

THE SERIES AGAINST UTT

LCU leads the all-times series 1-0 against the Patriots and the prior meeting was Feb. 1, 2020 in Tyler.

 No.8 Lubbock Christian University relied on 60% shooting in the second half and utilized a combined 38 points (19 each) from Maddi Chitsey and Ashton Duncan to end a three-game road losing streak with a 73-55 win over UT-Tyler inside Louise Herrington Patriot Center.

Duncan was on fire from outside in the game, going a 6-of-8 from downtown, with the six three-pointers marking a career high. The six treys were the most by a Lady Chap since Tess Bruffey con-

nected with six against Southwestern Oklahoma State on Dec. 7, 2017.

She opened the game 4-of-4 from outside in the opening quarter of play. While she was perfect from the field in the quarter, her teammates were a combined 2-of-11. All four Duncan three-pointers were the opening buckets of the game for LCU, who led 12-2 after her fourth made shot (in the opening 6:25 of the game). LCU led 16-6 after the first quarter.

Maddi Chitsey, who matched a career high with 17 field goal attempts, had seven attempts in the second quarter and led LCU with six points in the quarter. UT Tyler closed the half on a 7-1 run cutting LCU's lead to 28-23 at the halftime break. Duncan led LCU with 13 points in the opening half. She was the only Lady Chap dialed in from outside, as while she was 4-of-4 in the half, five of her teammates (the rest with an attempt) were a combined 0-of-10 from long range in the half. Meanwhile, LCU was 50% (7-of-14) from inside the arc in the half.

The second half opened with a momentum change in the contest, as the Patriots made six consecutive field goal attempts in a span in which they opened the half outscoring LCU 12-5 to take a 35-32 lead. Caitlyn Cunyus responded with a rhythm for LCU, as she had a layup and later a three-pointer during a 9-0 LCU run to take a 42-35 lead.

The Lady Chaps had a string of seven straight field goals made. They closed the third quarter on a 6-0 run (led 51-43 at the end of the third quarter) and it was part of an eventual 16-5 run for a 61-48 advantage. Cunyus had another three-pointer in that run, with the run also aided by a Laynee Burr three-point-play. The Lady Chaps closed the game on a 7-0 run, with Cunyus connecting on a third three-pointer of the half to cap a 15-point second half.

LCU was 18-of-30 (60%) from the field in the second half, going 13-of-19 (68.4%) inside the arc. Chitsey, who was 9-of-15 inside the arc, matched Duncan with a game-high 19 points, and they were half of LCU's double-digit point producers. Cunyus (15 points) and Allie Schulte (11 points) joined the pair offensively. Schulte also had six assists and four steals.

The Patriots, in their first season at the Division II level after spending last season at NCAA Division III, received 12 points from Kelsey Crouse. They shot 42.9% from the field, which was a season high by an LCU opponent, marking only their second opponent this season to finish above 40% from the field. They fell to 3-16 overall and 1-14 in LSC play.

In 10 seasons at the helm while an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons at the helm, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the results have not changed since transitioning. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season. That led to an astounding 2015-2016 season. A season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually a NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2015-16 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

LCU's title defense was rudely interrupted by the COVID Pandemic in 2019-20. LCU was 28-3 and claimed the Lone Star Conference Championship during their first season in the conference. LCU was chosen to host the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals for a third time, but the COVID shutdown halted the remainder of the season less than 24 hours prior to the first tournament game.

In 17 seasons at LCU (the 2020-21 season marks his 18th), Gomez enters the 2020-2021 season with a 425-125 collegiate coaching record. The 2020-21 season marks LCU's eighth since leaving the NAIA and LCU is 191-29 in that span (86.8%).

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific.

LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University.

In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU.

LCU had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded.

In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 30 years, and the couple has two sons: Hayden and Landon.



VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011.



KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

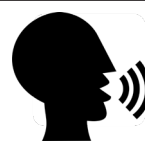
Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She played an integral role in the coaching staff when the Lady Chaps went on to win the NCAA Div. II National Championship in the 2015-16 season. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

The Lubbock Christian University Lady Chaparrals became the third program in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to reach 80 consecutive home wins, as the Lady Chaps completed a two-game weekend sweep of St. Mary's with a 67-57 Lone Star Conference victory for their 80 consecutive home win inside Rip Griffin Center. The streak actively leads all levels of NCAA women's basketball.

LCU benefited off a strong first-half shooting performance to reach the home victory. LCU trailed 6-2, opening the first four minutes of the game 1-of-4 from the field. Emma Middleton connected on a three-pointer with 5:35 left in the quarter and LCU went on an 8-of-11 shooting stretch from the field. LCU had a 9-0 run and an eventual 6-0 run to close the quarter, as Madelyn Turner and Laynee Burr each hit three-pointers to give LCU a 19-10 lead at the end of the first quarter. The Lady Chaps also had a 9-0 run and an 8-0 run in the second quarter.

LCU shot 61.5% (16/26) in the opening half (8-of-12, 66.7% in the second quarter) and led 40-21 at the half. They received field goals from nine different players, and six different players connected on a three-point field goal in the half, as LCU was 7-of-11 (63.6%) from downtown in the half.

The hot shooting wouldn't return in the second half. Neither team could find their shooting touch in the third quarter. LCU turned the ball over five times and missed their first six shot attempts of the half. The Lady Chaps went a five-minute span without a point, but the best StMU could do was one field goal and a 6-0 run during the LCU lull. Allie Schulte ended the dry spell with a layup as 4:54 remained in the quarter, which began a 9-0 LCU run, LCU closed the quarter on an 11-2 run for a 51- 29 lead.

Each team shot 25% from the field in the third quarter. The teams did warm back up in the fourth quarter. Especially St. Mary's, who went 7-of-11 (63.6) from the field in the quarter (Rattlers connected on three three-pointers in the frame).

Schulte led LCU with a balanced performance. She led the team in scoring (11 points), rebounds (6), assists (5) and steals (5). Her five steals matched a career high. LCU did have 13 different players factor into the scoring and had six players with at least seven points. They finished the game 46.4% (26/56) from the field. LCU had 12 blocks Friday, but only recorded one Saturday.

St. Mary's (0-2, 0-2) received a double-double from Hannah Wilson, who led the LSC in double-doubles last season. She had 13 points and 12 rebounds, serving as the only Rattler in double digits in either category.

LCU (2-0, 2-0) claimed their ninth consecutive win over StMU in the all-time series, which they lead 18-3.

TURNING POINT

LCU's turning point in the contest was conducted over a span 9:34, which started in the first quarter. LCU went on a 26-6 run, which turned a 6-2 deficit into a 28-12 lead. They were 10-of-16 from the field in the stretch. LCU was 5-of-6 from three-point range in the stretch. The long distance sequence was part of a first-half stretch in which LCU went 7-of-9 from three-point range, with Madelyn Turner serving as the only Lady Chap to hit two three-pointers in the span.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Saturday marked the fourth time in which LCU's leading scorer scored 11 points or less (two of the four were early in the 2016-17 season. The last time it occurred was Feb. 27, 2020, as Ashton Duncan led LCU with 11 points against UT Permian Basin.
