DID YOU MISS US?

No.1 Lubbock Christian University finally returns to action Thursday after having their last four scheduled games postponed. LCU, which has been practicing during the entirety of their layoff, has not played since defeating Midwestern State in Lubbock January 27. They return to action hosting Western New Mexico for a pair of games, as the two teams will play Thursday and Friday inside Rip Griffin Center. WNMU is a Lone Star Conference member, but none of their games are counting as conference contests as they were unable to commit to a full schedule of competition due to COVID protocols in New Mexico. The Mustangs have not played since Jan. 24.

WAY BACK WHEN

LCU was coming off an 84-54 home win over Midwestern State when they learned that their trip to Wichita Falls, Texas (Jan. 30) to complete the West Division home-and-home weekly series would be postponed. LCU's Ashton Duncan and

Allie Schulte each co-led LCU in the contest against MSU with 20 points. Schulte surpasses 1,000 career points in the game. LCU outscored MSU by 20 points in the second half, scoring 29 points in the fourth quarter of the win.

HOW DID THAT HAPPEN?

Just something to ponder... On Jan. 14, LCU faced Angelo State in what was LCU's fifth game of the season and ASU's season opener (LCU played their season opener on Dec. 11). Entering Thursday, Angelo State has played 10 games, while LCU has played nine games. LCU's nine games matches Arkansas - Fort Smith, Texas Woman's and Texas A&M International as the fewest games played by LSC programs (outside of WNMU). TWU and LCU have played the same number of games despite TWU not playing their second game of the season until Jan. 22.

STEALING THE SHOW

LCU enters the week ranked 19th in steals per game (11.7). The Lady Chaps have had at least 10 steals in seven of their last eight games. Allie Schulte leads the team in steals (29) and averages 3.2 per game to lead the LSC (33rd nationally).

LONG DISTANCE CALLS

Despite only playing nine games, LCU ranks third in the LSC in three-point field goals (94), averaging a conference-best 10.4 average per game (seventh in the nation). They average 10.3 three-pointers per game at home. The Lady Chaps success rate of 42.2% shooting from outside is third nationally. Ashton Duncan leads LCU with 32 three-pointers (33rd nationally) and leads the LSC, ranking fourth nationally with a conference-best rate of 3.56 per game. Schulte ranks fourth nationally and leads the conference with a three-point shooting percentage of 59.4%, and Duncan ranks second in the conference at 47.8%. Eleven (11) different Lady Chaps have at least one three-pointer on the season.

ALLIE CAT

The sharp shooting of Allie Schulte is registering nationally. Schulte leads the LSC and ranks second nationally in field goal percentage with a mark of 68.0%. From long range, she ranks fourth nationally with a conference-best rate of 59.4%. In nine games this season, she has two-or-less missed shots in seven of the games. She has not shot less than 60% in a game this season.

THROWING STONES

A look at upcoming milestones on the horizon for Lady Chap members:

- Allie Schulte ranks ninth nationally in Division II active players in career games played with 109.
- Is 25 assists away from 300 career assists.
- Actively ranks 28th in career assists with 275 assists.
- Ashton Duncan needs one three-pointer to reach 150 career three-pointers.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

There is a new "No.1" in NCAA Division II women's college basketball, as both the WBCA and D2SIDA each released their weekly Top-25 Polls Tuesday with Lubbock Christian University replacing Drury as the top team.

LCU last held the No.1 ranking in January of 2020, coming off the 2019 NCAA Division II national championship season. With no basketball championships held last season due to Covid-19, LCU remains as the reigning national champions. They are 9-0 this season and one of four teams in NCAA Division II that have an 8-0 record or better. Charleston (WV) and Lander are each 10-0. Drury fell out of the top spot after falling to unranked Rockhurst.

WHEN AT HOME

LCU went 13-0 last season inside Rip Griffin Center. They enter Thursday's play 6-0 this season at home and with their active home win streak sitting at 84 games, which ranks third all-time in NCAA Division II women's basketball (it actively leads all of NCAA). The record is 87 consecutive home victories by Nebraska-Kearney, who completed the task from Jan. 31, 1995 - Nov. 24, 2001. LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix, has also won 72 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games (they are 19-0 in LSC home games).

MORE ON THE HOME FRONT

Ashton Duncan leads LCU at home this season, averaging 15.8 points per game. Allie Schulte also averages double figures at home, with an average of 14.0 points per home contest. LCU has a 34-6 advantage in blocks at home and they have held opponents to 35.6% shooting. The Lady Chaps are shooting 49.9% on the Rip Griffin Center floor this season, with a 46.3% shooting mark from outside. LCU, averaging 10.4 three-point field goals per home game, have Duncan shooting 61.4% from outside at home. She is 27-of-44 at home this season from outside.

BLOCKS ARE BACK

Since their first season as official NCAA Division II members (2015-16), LCU has ranked at least 12th or better in total blocks (led the nation in 15-16 and ranked second in 17-18) in each season of play and have ranked in the top-14 in four of the five seasons in blocks per game (led the nation in 15-16 and 16-17). This season, LCU looks as if they may keep the trend continuing. They ranked in the top-10 until several game postponements have them currently ranking 27th in blocks (51) and are seventh in blocks per game (5.7), leading the LSC in the per-game category. Emma Middleton (18, third in the conference and 36th nationally), Whitney Cox (12, seventh in the LSC) and Juliana Robertson (9, 12th in the conference) place LCU with three players in the top-12 in the LSC in blocks. Middleton also leads the LSC and 22nd nationally with 2.00 blocks per game.

DISTRIBUTION

With a mark of 1.37, LCU ranks fifth in the nation in assist/turnover ratio. LCU's 17.8 assists per game ranks 10th in the nation, with team leader Allie Schulte averaging 3.18 per game to lead the conference and rank sixth nationally. Juliana Robertson is not far behind, ranking second in the conference with a mark of 2.9 per game (eighth nationally). Madelyn Turner (2.6) is also averaging over 2.0 assists per game. LCU ranks 17th nationally in turnovers per game (leads the LSC) with a mark of 13.0 per game (they rank 18th in turnovers forced and sixth in turnover margin).

LAST LINE OF DEFENSE

Along with ranking 19th nationally in steals per game, LCU's defense is holding opponents to 47.9 points per game (leads the nation). From the floor, opponents are shooting 34.0% (16th nationally).

UNBLEMISHED

LCU is the only program in the South Central Region without a loss and they are one of 10 programs nationally in Division II that are active and have not lost.

CHARITY STRIPE

The Lady Chaps have not missed more than three free-throws in a game this season, and they are 44-of-47 in their prior two combined games (93.6%). On the season, LCU ranks second nationally, shooting 83.3% from the free-throw line. Emma Middleton leads LCU at the charity stripe with an 87.5% free-throw shooting percentage (21/24).

FIVE THINGS ABOUT WNMU

- 1 > The Mustangs are coming off an 8-18 season in 2019-20, finishing 5-17 in the Lone Star Conference and 0-10 in the division (last season they were in the same division as LCU). They went 5-8 in road contests.
- 2 > WNMU has been limited to two regular season games this season. They fell to UT Permian Basin

3 > After Thursday and Friday's game, WNMU will have one game remaining, as they will travel to Wichita Falls, Texas to face Midwestern State. The Mustangs have had five games postponed due to COVID protocols.

4 > Destiny Johnson and Olivia Lee lead the Mustangs and each have had a 14-point performance this season.

5 > WNMU is amidst their first season with Josh Pace coaching the Mustangs. Their win over Park Gilbert provided Pace with his first coaching victory.

THE SERIES AGAINST WNMU

The Mustangs and Lady Chaps are set to meet for the 21st time in an all-time series that dates back to 1980. The series is tied 10-10 despite the fact WNMU has not defeated the Lady Chaps since 1994. LCU has won the prior six meetings, with the latest resulting in an 68-37 win on Feb. 29 in Silver City, N.M. LCU is 3-3 in Silver City, N.M. against WNMU, but have not met there since Nov. 20, 2007 (85-55 LCU win). LCU is 5-2 in Lubbock against WNMU (four straight wins). Last season's home-and-home conference schedule marked the first time the two teams had a home-and-home set scheduled in a single season since 1994, when each were members of the NAIA.

PREVIOUS RECAP VS. WNMU

Feb. 29, 2020 (Silver City, N.M.) - WNMU:37 - LCU:68

A 20-0 run in the first quarter opened a dominating performance by No.6 Lubbock Christian University, as they surged to a 68-37 Lone Star Conference division victory over Western New Mexico in the regular season finale inside Drag's Court.

LCU's 20-0 run helped them overcome a 10-6 deficit and it closed the first quarter of play to give LCU a 26-10 lead. The Lady Chaps dominating run was part of a scoring binge in which LCU outscored WNMU 46-10 over a stretch of 20:24.

Along with the run and offensive spark, LCU also out-scored WNMU 22-2 in points-off turnovers, 44-6 in paint scoring and 14-0 in second-chance scoring. A majority of the damage was in the opening half, as LCU had an 18-0 advantage in points-off-turnovers and 22-4 advantage in paint scoring in the opening half of play. LCU held WNMU to 20% (5/25) shooting in the first half and had 12 points each from Maddi Chitsey and Allie Schulte to take a 42-17 halftime lead.

During LCU's 46-10 run, WNMU was 2-of-23 (8.7%) from the field. They had a series of nine straight field goal misses and 11 consecutive misses. Their streak of 11 straight misses ended with a Paulina Rodriguez three-pointer, which also ended the 46-10 run. Prior to the three-pointer, LCU had the lead built to a 32-point advantage (52-20 with 7:20 remaining in the third quarter).

Rodriguez's three-pointer started a stretch in which WNMU was 5-of-10 from the field, but they closed the game missing their final nine shot attempts and finished the game shooting 21.7% (10/46) from the field. WNMU was 5-of-30 (16.7%) inside the arc. Rodriguez finished with a game-high 15 points. The Mustangs also received 10 points from Kayla Clark.

LCU, 43.8% from the field (28/64), received 14 points each from Maddi Chitsey and Allie Schulte. They also received 11 points from Madelyn Turner and 10 points from Emma Middleton. Juliana Robertson had the most intriguing stat line, posting 10 rebounds and two steals without any points scored. LCU was making their first visit to WNMU since Nov. 20, 2007.

KEEP IN MIND

The Lone Star Conference announced it will use a point rating system to determine its men's and women's basketball standings this year due to COVID-19 related schedule adjustments.

The point rating system will replace winning percentage for the LSC's basketball conference standings, divisional standings and conference tournament seeding in 2020-21.

The system assigns a numerical value to game results depending on the site and quality of the opponent. Teams will earn more points for a win on the road or at home against top competition based on conference winning percentage and receive fewer points for a win against lesser opposition. Points are also dispersed for losses, with more points awarded for a loss against stronger competition.

Each week, the team ratings will be determined by taking the total points divided by league games played with the opponents winning percentage updated throughout the year.

The LSC has the point system in use for public viewing on the standings page located on the LSC's website.

The change will help offset an unbalanced league schedule and games canceled due to COVID-19. Typically, the LSC slate includes games against all other league teams but this year is using a modified "bubble" schedule format to enhance student-athlete safety with regard to COVID-19 and reduce the amount of contact amongst teams by playing the same opponent twice during the week.

The conference tournament will consist of the top eight men's and women's teams with first-round games on-campus on Tuesday, March 2 followed by the four winning teams advancing to the final site at the highest remaining seed on Friday, March 5 and Saturday, March 6.

LSC POINT RATING SYSTEM

Points shall be awarded for each conference contest played:

7 points – win over a .750 or better team on the road
 6.5 points – win over a .750 or better team at home
 6 points – win over a .500 or better team on the road
 5 points – win over a .500 or better team at home
 4.5 points – win over a .250 or better team on the road
 4 points – win over a .250 team or better at home
 3.5 points – win over an under .250 team on the road
 3 points – win over an under .250 team at home
 2.5 points – loss at home or on the road to a .750 or better team
 2 points – loss to a .500 or better team at home or on the road
 1 point – loss to a .250 or better team at home or on the road
 .5 points – loss to an under .250 team on the road
 0 points – loss to an under .250 team at home

COVID AND VIEWING OPTIONS

COVID-19 regulations by LCU will have the Rip Griffin Center at 50% capacity. All home game ticket and spectator policies are subject to change on a game-by-game basis. For games allowing fans, a limited number of tickets are available (admission covers both men's and women's games on that date) to the general public on www.lcuchaps.com/tickets.

Each game will be broadcast on the LSC Digital Network as an option for fans unable to attend. The Lone Star Conference have a new hybrid pricing model for the LSC Digital Network this season. The broadcasts of volleyball and men's and women's basketball games will be available via pay-per-view (PPV) conference-wide under the new model. Fans can purchase a \$10 daily pass that will give them access to all LSC football, volleyball and basketball contests on the network that day, as well as access to previously aired games from the current season for 24 hours. In addition to live and archived streaming options, viewers will have the option to purchase and download games from the 2020-21 season for \$10 each. Select games of all other sports carried on the LSC Digital Network will be available free-to-view (FTV) or PPV at the discretion of the broadcasting institution. The LSC Digital Network is in its second year showcasing the academic and athletic events of the league and its 18 member institutions. Fans can watch games and purchase passes online at www.lonestarconferencenetwork.com or www.lcuchaps.com/live on computer and mobile devices. Viewers can also tune in to games on the LSC Digital Network via OTT apps available on Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV, Android TV and Roku by searching for "LSC Digital Network."

In 10 seasons at the helm while an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons at the helm, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the results have not changed since transitioning. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season. That led to an astounding 2015-2016 season. A season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually a NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2015-16 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

LCU's title defense was rudely interrupted by the COVID Pandemic in 2019-20. LCU was 28-3 and claimed the Lone Star Conference Championship during their first season in the conference. LCU was chosen to host the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals for a third time, but the COVID shutdown halted the remainder of the season less than 24 hours prior to the first tournament game.

In 17 seasons at LCU (the 2020-21 season marks his 18th), Gomez enters the 2020-2021 season with a 425-125 collegiate coaching record. The 2020-21 season marks LCU's eighth since leaving the NAIA and LCU is 191-29 in that span (86.8%).

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific.

LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University.

In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU.

LCU had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded.

In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 30 years, and the couple has two sons: Hayden and Landon.



VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011.



KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

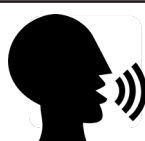
Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She played an integral role in the coaching staff when the Lady Chaps went on to win the NCAA Div. II National Championship in the 2015-16 season. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

A career-high six steals couldn't steal the spotlight away from Allie Schulte's biggest achievement of the night. The senior guard had 20 points, which helped her surpass 1,000 career points as a member of the Lady Chaps, and No.2 Lubbock Christian University used a strong second half surge to defeat Midwestern State 84-54 in a West Division meeting in the Lone Star Conference. Ashland Duncan also added 20 points to help LCU claim its 84th consecutive home win inside Rip Griffin Center (72nd consecutive conference home win).

Schulte, entering the game needing 16 points to hit the 1,000-point mark, converted a free-throw to complete a three-point play with 8:23 remaining in the contest for her 16th point of the game and the 1,000th of her career. Her accomplishment marks the third consecutive season a Lady Chap has hit the mark. Olivia Robertson completed the task in March of 2019 and Maddi Chitsey hit the 1,000-point mark in November of 2019 in San Antonio, Texas.

Eight of her points were valuable in the second quarter, as LCU had to hold off a Midwestern State surge of momentum. LCU opened the game on a 9-0 run, but Midwestern State responded with a 6-0 run once their first field goal went in four minutes into the game. MSU outscored LCU 14-6 over the final six minutes of the first quarter and LCU edged MSU 15-14 heading into the second quarter. Schulte had six of LCU's first eight points of the second quarter, with her first field goal regaining the LCU lead after Frances King nailed a three-pointer to tie the game at 17-17 36 seconds into the quarter. LCU's defense held MSU without a field goal for over a four-minute span, while Ashton Duncan ignited a 14-2 run by scoring five of the first seven points of the run. Duncan and Schulte combined for 13 points in the quarter and LCU took a 37-27 lead into the half. LCU was 9-of-13 (69.2%) from the field in the second quarter and they were 7-of-8 inside the arc in the frame.

MSU was held to one scoring run in the third quarter. After a 4-0 run answered an LCU 5-0 run, LCU outscored MSU 11-6 in the quarter. All 11 of LCU's points were scored by Emma Middleton (6) and Schulte (5).

LCU's offense surged in the fourth quarter. Duncan opened the quarter with a three-pointer for a 58-41 lead. The three-pointer was the first points of an eventual 19-3 LCU run to build the lead to 74-44, matching the largest lead of the game. Duncan (8) and Schulte (7) combined for 15 points in the fourth quarter.

LCU finished the game 54.5% (30/55) from the field. Duncan and Schulte each finished the game with 20 points. Duncan was 8-of-12 from the field with a 4-of-7 mark from outside. Schulte was 8-of-13 from the field and also added six assists and a career-high six steals. Middleton finished with 14 points and posted three blocks and a +31 plus/minus.

Defensively, LCU held MSU to 38.9% shooting from the field. LCU outscored MSU 42-22 in the paint (42 points is a season high in paint scoring) and 24-11 in points-off-turnovers, as they had 13 steals and forced MSU into 20 turnovers. The 13 steals marks the seventh time (nine games played) in which LCU has swiped at least 10 steals in a game this season. LCU moved to 3-0 in the West and 9-0 in conference play and overall.

MSU, making their second trip to Lubbock Christian since 1994, had three players finish in double figures, with King leading the Mustangs with 12 points. Morgan Lenahan and Hannah Reynolds each had 10 points, with Lenahan's points all scored in the fourth quarter. The Mustangs fell to 7-3 overall, 6-3 in conference play and 1-2 in the West Division.

TURNING POINT

From the time 3:33 remained in the third quarter, until 2:27 remained in the game, LCU was 13-of-19 from the field (68.4%). Inside the 19 field goal attempts was a string of seven consecutive made field goals, with Emma Middleton (3 field goals), Ashton Duncan (2 field goals) and Allie Schulte (3) combining to complete the task.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS

LCU was 94.4% from the free-throw line in the game, making 17 of 18 attempts. Juliana Robertson (6-of-6) and Emma Middleton (4-of-4) combined to go 10-of-10 from the line. LCU has not missed more than three free-throws in a game this season, and they are 44-of-47 in their prior two combined games (93.6%).
