WELCOME HOME

No.13 Lubbock Christian University opens their home slate of the 2022-23 season hosting the Carpet Tech Classic inside Rip Griffin Center. Action inside Rip Griffin Center will consist of a pair of games Friday and Saturday. Friday, following a 3:30 p.m. tip between UT Tyler and Colorado State Pueblo, LCU will host Colorado Christian (6 p.m. scheduled tip), and Saturday LCU will host CSU Pueblo (estimated 6 p.m. tip) after UT Tyler clashes with Colorado Christian (3:30 p.m. start). The pair of home games begins a stretch in which LCU plays six of seven games at home.

NOT AS ROUGH AS IT LOOKS

There is no need to hit the panic button following LCU's first 0-2 start since the 2016-17 season. Last weekend at the D2CCA Tip-Off Classic in Kansas City, LCU fell to No.6 Missouri Southern State (65-64) and to Missouri Western State 101-96 in overtime. The Lady Chaps didn't appear inexperienced (they were opening the season playing with five new starters for the first time in Steve Gomez's 20 seasons at the helm of the Lady Chaps), as they led in the final minute of regulation in each of the games (facing MSSU, the regional favorites according to D2SIDA, and MWSU, who was an Elite Eight qualifier last season). LCU showed they can score, as Grace Foster lit up Missouri Western State for 36 points. LCU has four players averaging double figures in points (Grace Foster 26.0, Audrey Robertson 11.0, Maci Maddox 10.5 and Shaylee Stovall 10.0) and a trio of players average at least 7.0 rebounds (Cox 8.5, Foster 8.5 and Robertson 7.5).

their All-Tournament selections and Grace Foster was Lubbock Christian University's representative on All-Tournament Team. Foster, a sophomore from Childress, Texas, led all players at the tournament, conducted in Kansas City, Mo. at Municipal Auditorium, with 26.0 points per game. Her marquee performance was a 36-point performance against Western State Sunday, as she had LCU's highest single-game point total since Nov. 5, 2010 (Emily Pool, 36 points against Northern New Mexico College) and it tied for the fourth-highest single-game point total in LCU program history. She was 13-of-20 from the field in the game, with her 13 field goals marking the most by a Lady Chap since Mar. 1, 2013 (Kelsey Canavan, 13 against Rogers State). Foster opened the season with her second career double-double, posting 16 points and 11 boards against No.6 Missouri Southern State. With 12 points in the second half against SMSU and 20 points in the second half against MWSU, she averaged 16.0 points in the second half of play on the week. Defensively, she averaged 2.0 blocks per game. Foster's tournament numbers included going 60-percent (6-of-10) from three-point range.

SEASON NOTES AND TRENDS

>Grace Foster has a pair of double-figure contests to open the season, which matches her career-high completed twice her freshman season. On January 6 (vs Arkansas Fort Smith) and Jan. 13 (at Texas A&M-Commerce), Foster posted 14 and 20 points.

>Whitney Cox posted career-highs in points (6) and rebounds (6) Saturday against MSSU, and followed Sunday (against MWSU) with her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds to establish new career-high marks.

>The Lady Chaps are averaging 42.5 rebounds per game through their opening pair of contests, posting a high of 46 against MSSU. LCU has not averaged over 40 rebounds in a season since averaging 40.3 during the 2015-16 season.

>Sunday, LCU was 29-of-33 (87.9%) from the free-throw line. The 29 free-throws were tied for the fifth-most since LCU began competing with a NCAA schedule (2013-14) and their highest mark since 30 against Lander last season (Nov. 19, 2021). On the campaign, LCU is shooting 82.1% (46/56) from the line. Audrey Robertson (10-of-12) and Shaylee Stovall (15-of-18) are each shooting 83.3% from the line to lead the team (of those reaching minimum requirements).

>LCU's allowance of 101 points Sunday to MWSU was a rarity. The 101 points marked the second time an LCU opponent has scored at least 100 points against LCU during Steve Gomez's tenure as the Lady Chaps head coach. The last time LCU allowed at least 100 points was on Jan. 31, 2004 in a 101-62 loss to Oklahoma Christian, which was during Gomez's first season with the Lady Chaps. Overall in program history, Missouri Western's 101 points marked the 10th time in LCU program history in which they allowed at least 100 points in a contest.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

D2SIDA (Division II Sports Information Directors Association) and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) each announced their preseason top-25 rankings for the 2022-2023 season, with D2SIDA ranking Lubbock Christian University No.13 and the WBCA ranking the Lady Chaparrals No.23.

LCU has found their way into the D2SIDA preseason poll nine consecutive seasons, marking every season they have been eligible to appear (due to the transfer from NAIA to NCAA Div. II), ranking No.1 (2019-20 and in 2021-22), No.3 (2018-19 and in 2020-21), No.23 (2017-18), No. 4 (2016-17), No.15 (2015-16) and receiving votes in 2014-15. The Lady Chaps No.13 ranking is the second-best among South Central Region programs, as West Texas A&M holds the No.7 ranking.

The WBCA NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Preseason Poll, which the WBCA did not conduct during the 2020-21 season (COVID), is a poll LCU has consistently debut in each season a poll has been conducted since being eligible. Carrying the No.1 ranking last season, this season's No.23 ranking ends a streak of three consecutive top-10 preseason poll appearances. Along with their three consecutive top-10 debuts (No.1 in 2021-22, No.2 in 2019-20, No. 10 in 2018-19), LCU has claimed No.11

(2016-17) and No.18 (2015-16) in their prior appearances in the poll.

SO ARE SOME OTHERS

LCU faced a nationally ranked program Saturday, falling to No.6 Southern Missouri State. LCU went 6-0 against nationally ranked programs in 2020-21 and 3-2 in 2021-22 against the nations ranked foes (opened 3-0). LCU's season opener marked the first time since the 2017-18 season opener in Commerce, Texas in which LCU opened against a national ranked opponent (LCU topped No.5 CSU-Pueblo 57-52). This Saturday, with LCU facing a program receiving top-25 votes (CSU Pueblo), three of their four games this season will have been against nationally ranked teams or teams receiving votes.

SWEET HOME (ON) CHICAGO

LCU went 13-0 at home last season, which has their active home win streak sitting at 104 games (it is the active and all-time leading mark in NCAA Division II women's basketball). LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA post-season play in Lubbock in the mix (not including a 4-0 mark in LSC post-season play), has also won 82 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games (they are 29-0 in LSC home games).

FIVE THINGS ABOUT CCU

1 > The Cougars followed a 5-13 season in 2020-21 with a 9-18 overall record last season. They went 6-15 in Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference contests, which had them tied for 12th place. They went 3-9 in road contests.

2 > CCU is preseason picked 11th in the RMAC Preseason Poll.

3 > Agnes Paul and Sydney Priddy are the returning starters on the CCU squad. Paul averaged 6.5 rebounds per game and tallied 168 total last season. Priddy, who will run point, averaged 5.3 points and handed out 80 assists last season. CCU has eight new players on roster entering the season.

4 > Colorado Christian faced a pair of Division I programs to complete their exhibition schedule. The Cougars fell to Wyoming (68-36) and Colorado State (78-47). Regan Loconte led the Cougars with 12 points against Wyoming and Victoria Perez came off the bench to lead the Cougars with nine points against the Rams.

5 > Lourdes Gonzalez is the one of only two seniors on the Cougars roster. She averaged 11.4 points per game and 7.3 rebounds last season.

THE SERIES AGAINST CCU

LCU and Colorado Christian have met two prior times (series split 1-1), meeting last season (60-46 LCU season-opening win on November 12, 2021) to mark the first meeting between the two squads since an invitational hosted by Colorado Christian on Dec. 3-4, 1993. The Dec. 4, 1993 meeting marked the first meeting, with Colorado Christian winning 72-55.

PRIOR MEETING VS. CCU

LAKEWOOD, Colo. (November 12, 2021) - Laynee Burr notched a second consecutive career-high performance, as she posted 19 points (13 in the second half) to help Lubbock Christian University spoil Colorado Christian's home and season opener with a 60-46 win inside CCU Event Center.

After 2:35 of scoreless basketball to open the game, Ashton Duncan took the lid off the basket with a three-pointer from the left corner for an opening 3-0 lead for LCU. That was LCU's only basket for a five-minute stretch, as LCU was 1-of-9 from the field to start the game. The dry spell ended with 2:23 left in the quarter with Audrey Robertson connecting with a three-pointer from the same left-wing corner as Duncan. Despite a 2-of-11 (18.2%) shooting performance in the quarter (both field goals were three-pointers), LCU led 10-9 after the opening quarter.

Duncan hit another three-pointer in the second quarter, and it was part of an 8-0 LCU run for a 19-11 lead. The run came, as LCU held CCU without a field goal for a span of 6:46. The

Cougars responded scoring nine of the next 13 points. They cut the LCU to three points before Whitney Cox had a layup with five seconds left to give LCU a 27-22 halftime lead.

Burr, Channing Cunyus and Duncan each had six points to co-lead LCU at the half. LCU shot 32.1% from the field in the first half.

LCU opened the second half on a 15-2 run (17-2 if Cox's basket to end the first half is included), which was capped by three consecutive three-pointers. Burr followed Duncan's third three-pointer of the game with back-to-back three-pointers during the run and LCU led 42-24 with 4:38 left in the quarter. Burr finished with 10 points in the quarter and LCU took a 46-31 lead into the fourth quarter.

She added to her totals in the fourth quarter with an and-one three-point play 3:06 into the fourth quarter, which was part of an 8-0 run to start the quarter. Burr had a free-throw for the final point of the run, which provided LCU a 53-31 lead for the largest lead of the game (6:54 remaining). LCU held CCU without a field goal for the opening 3:17 of the quarter and for an overall span of 3:57.

LCU utilized their bench in much of the fourth quarter, as all 15 active players spent time on the floor. Seven different players had at least one point, as Burr and Shaylee Stovall each co-led LCU in the quarter with three points.

The Lady Chaps (4-0) won despite shooting 32.1% (18/56) from the field. Burr was 7-of-12 from the field, while the rest of the Lady Chaps were a combined 11-of-44 (25%). Duncan and Cunyus each finished with 10 points, with Cunyus co-leading the team (Juliana Robertson) in rebounds with eight. LCU had an 18-6 scoring advantage from the free-throw line, as they were 18-of-21 (85.7%) from the line. They made 13 consecutive free-

throws before their first miss of the game (streak was 17 consecutive made free-throws going back to Sunday's game against Tampa). Cunyus was 6-of-6 from the charity stripe. LCU received five steals from Allie Schulte, as the Lady Chaps had a 15-9 advantage in turnovers forced.

CCU (0-1) was led by Agnes Paul, who scored 12 points and added eight rebounds to lead the team in each category. Diane Thompson was making her head coaching debut for the Cougars.

FIVE THINGS ABOUT CSUP

1 > The ThunderWolves rebounded from a 3-13 season in 2020-21 (all were conference games) with a 23-7 record overall and they went 17-5 in conference to tie for second in the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) last season. They qualified for the NCAA Division II South Central Regional, where they fell to LCU 65-57.

2 > Colorado State - Pueblo was preseason picked second in the RMAC Preseason Poll. They are receiving votes in the D2SIDA Preseason Top-25 Poll.

3 > CSU-Pueblo played a pair of exhibition games in preparation for the regular season, but each went with unreported scores. They faced Denver and Air Force's junior varsity program. They open the season Friday facing UT Tyler in Lubbock.

4 > Head coach Tommie Johnson made his ThunderWolves head coaching debut against LCU. The debut marked the third consecutive coaching debut against LCU by a CSU-Pueblo women's basketball head coach. Jim Turgeon (2015) and Curtis Loyd (2017) were prior CSU-Pueblo head coaches who faced LCU in their ThunderWolves coaching debut.

5 > Alisha Davis had some big games against the Lady Chaps last season, as she posted 18 points and 23 points to average 20.5 points per game against the Lady Chaps during the season.

THE SERIES AGAINST CSUP

LCU leads the all-time series at 7-5 against CSUP (formerly known as Southern Colorado). The home team won the first five meetings, with LCU bucking that trend with a 2015-16 season-opening win in Pueblo. The two teams met twice last season, as LCU fell 64-56 to the ThunderWolves in Lakewood, Colo., but rebounded to defeat CSUP 66-57 on Mar. 11 in Canyon, Texas at the South Central Regional. The first two all-time meetings came down to the final buzzer. On Dec. 9, 1989 in Lubbock, Burgandy Bass hit the game winning shot at the horn for a 58-56 LCU win. Nearly a year later, on Dec. 8, 1989 in Pueblo, LCU rallied back from a 63-55 deficit with 24 points from Sherry Blackwell, but a three-pointer at the buzzer didn't fall and LCU lost 73-72. Six of the prior nine meetings have been in Colorado (four in Pueblo) and under Steve Gomez's watch. LCU has a 3-0 series advantage in Lubbock, with the last Hub City meeting resulting in a 78-74 win Nov. 9, 2018.

PRIOR MEETING VS. CSUP

CANYON, Texas (March 11, 2022) - No.9 Lubbock Christian University made 10 of their final 13 shot attempts to surge past No.6-seed Colorado State Pueblo 65-57 in the Quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II Women's Basketball South Central Regional inside First United Bank Center.

LCU's 10-of-13 (76.9%) shooting flow opened with 2:03 left in the third quarter, and it came at an opportune time for the Lady Chaps. Trailing 40-38, Channing Cunyus hit a jumper with 2:03 remaining in the third quarter to tie the game 40-40. Cunyus' bucket opened a 5-0 run to help give LCU 43-40 lead. The Lady Chaps, behind seven points in the third quarter from Laynee Burr, led 44-42 at the end of the third quarter.

The Lady Chaps, scoring six of the final eight points of the third quarter, opened the fourth quarter on a 5-0 run (Burr with three of the points off a strong inside three-point play) to give LCU an 11-2 run and a 49-42 lead 1:26 into the final frame. The ThunderWolves responded with a 5-0 run after a Tomia Johnson three-pointer, cutting LCU's lead to 49-47, but CSU Pueblo would be unable to produce a scoring run for the game's final 7:46. Ashton Duncan nailed a three-pointer over 5-1 run in which she scored all five points, and Duncan's efforts built the lead to 54-48 with 6:08 remaining. Teams traded buckets, until an Allie Schulte field goal with 3:55 left sparked a 7-0 run for a 65-54 lead with 19 seconds remaining.

Schulte (8) and Duncan (7) combined for 15 points in the fourth quarter, with an additional five points supplied by Burr. LCU was 8-of-11 (72.7%) from the field in the fourth quarter.

LCU also produced an offensive quarter in the first quarter, but it took a bit to get going. Thankful for CSU Pueblo's 1-of-11 start of the game from the field, LCU was able to miss their first four shot attempts before making eight of their next nine attempts. LCU's first field goal came 3:15 into the game off a three-pointer from Duncan, who made her first two attempts to lead an 8-0 run for an 8-2 lead with 5:33 left in the quarter. The scoring push for LCU was during a span in which the T'Wolves went 5:28 without a field goal, and turned into a 13-2 run between CSU Pueblo field goals for the Lady Chaps. Burr hit a three-pointer with 34 seconds left in the quarter for a 20-10 lead, which was LCU's largest lead of the first half. Duncan led LCU with eight points in the first quarter, as LCU led 20-12 at the quarter's close.

The Lady Chaps went a span of 2-of-15 (13.3%) shooting from the field, and the shooting woes allowed CSU Pueblo to march back. A 12-4 scoring advantage by the ThunderWolves allowed them to tie the game at 26-26 with 3:09 left in the first half. Juliana Robertson scored four consecutive points with 2:18 left in the half and it led to LCU leading 30-29 at the half.

Robertson led LCU in scoring in the opening half with 10 points. She finished with 11 points and eight rebounds, which helped her record 94 career re-

Duncan (15) and Schulte (13) joined Burr and Robertson in double figures. Schulte's 13 points helped move her past Maddi Chitsey in LCU career scoring for NCAA postseason play with 185 points. LCU also received a career-high five steals from Cunyus.

Alisha Davis, who scored 18 points in CSU Pueblo's win over LCU in November, led all scorers with 23 points Friday. She was CSU Pueblo's only player with at least 10 points.

The 2022-23 season marks Steve Gomez's 20th season at the helm of the Lady Chaps and the 10th season at the NCAA level. He opens the campaign with a 476-132 record, which includes a 22-2 record in NCAA postseason play.

In his first 10 seasons at the helm, as LCU was an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship Tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the winning tradition did not change. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season.

That led to an astounding 2015-2016 season, which was a season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually their first NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2016-17 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

LCU's title defense was rudely interrupted by the COVID Pandemic in 2019-20. LCU was 28-3 and claimed the Lone Star Conference Championship during their first season in the conference. LCU was chosen to host the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals for a third time, but the COVID shutdown halted the remainder of the season less than 24 hours prior to the first tournament game.

COVID went from being a wall to a hurdle in 2020-21, and one the Lady Chaps would be able to jump over. Through many cancellations and unknowns, LCU claimed a Lone Star Conference title and went to Canyon, Texas, where they claimed a NCAA Division II South Central title and a berth to another NCAA Elite Eight Tournament in Columbus, Ohio. It was there, LCU would claim their third national title, with wins over Daemen, Central Missouri and Drury to complete a 23-0 perfect season. They were the first NCAA Division II program to complete two undefeated seasons.

The Lady Chaps were preseason favorites to open the 2021-22 season. LCU surpassed a NCAA Div. II record 100 consecutive home wins during the season, which ended at the South Central Regional with LCU falling in the title game to conclude the season with a 28-7 record. Lubbock Christian closed the 2021-22 season holding a 242-36 record (87.1%) since leaving the NAIA.

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific. LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University. In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU. They had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near-thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded. In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 31 years, and the couple has two sons: Hayden and Landon. Landon serves on the women's basketball coaching staff at Texas Tech.



VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boys' basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She has played an integral role in the coaching staff for all three NCAA national championships. Wilson was named to the Dave Campbell's Texas Basketball Top-40 Coaches Under-40 List in 2021. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

Grace Amazes, But Lady Chaps Fall In Overtime to Missouri Western State

Grace Foster Scores 36 Points and Is One of Six Lady Chaps To Notch Career-High Offensive Marks

No.13 Lubbock Christian University dropped another heartbreaker at the D2CCA Tip-Off Classic inside Municipal Auditorium, as Grace Foster's 36-point performance (tied for the fourth-most in program history) was not enough to lead the Lady Chaps past Missouri Western State, who claimed a 101-96 overtime victory Sunday evening.

After falling 65-64 to No.6 Missouri Southern State in a game that had 11 lead changes Saturday, LCU jumped into the mix Sunday in a tilt featuring 12 lead changes and LCU's first overtime contest since January 16, 2020 (69-68 loss at Eastern New Mexico). Despite the high volume of lead changes Sunday, LCU only led for 7:19, while MWSU had the lead for 31:33.

In each contest, LCU had a lead inside the final minute of regulation. Sunday, LCU went up 84-82 with Maci Maddox hitting a runner with 16 seconds remaining in the fourth quarter. MWSU wasted no time, driving in and dumping a feed to Connie Clarke, who laid it off the glass and in to tie the contest 84-84 with nine seconds left. LCU called a timeout and worked a final shot with two seconds left, but Whitney Cox never had a solid attempt, as she was tied up with a defender and was unable to get a foul call.

The Lady Chaps had a promising start to the overtime frame. Foster, who had 20 points in the second half, opened the scoring for LCU 22 seconds into overtime with a layup to start a 4-0 run. Cleao Murray ended the run with a three-pointer for the Griffons, but Cox hit a field goal with 2:49 left in the extra frame to put LCU up 90-87. The Lady Chaps would make one of their four field goal attempts and miss a pair of free-throw attempts (LCU entered OT 23-of-25 from the line) over the remaining 2:49 of the game. The game was tied 93-93 with 33 seconds left in overtime when the Griffons scored the next four points over a five second span, taking advantage of an LCU turnover for a 97-93 lead. Maddox had a layup with 16 seconds left to cut the deficit to 97-95, but her field goal was the lone LCU field goal over the aforementioned final 2:49 of the game. MWSU made their final six free-throw attempts to hold off the Lady Chaps in the final stanza.

LCU had to overcome obstacles through much of the regulation frame. The Griffons opened the game with their first nine points coming from beyond the arc. Their first two came on second-chance efforts and had MWSU with a 6-0 lead. They led as much as 21-13 in the first quarter, with Clark posting 10 points in the quarter to help give the Griffons a 22-15 advantage to start the second quarter. MWSU scored the opening bucket of the second quarter before LCU went on a 7-0 run (Martie McCoy with a trio of free-throws in the run for LCU) to cut the deficit to 24-22. With 5:22 left in the second quarter, Foster knocked down a three-pointer and Reese Schumann followed with a layup to give LCU a short-lived 27-26 lead. It was LCU's only lead of the first half, as the Griffons used a Trinity Knapp three-pointer to help end the half on a 4-0 run for a 39-33 lead. Foster, with seven points in the second quarter, led all scorers with 12 points at the break, while Clarke and Brionna Budgetts co-lead the Griffons with 10 points each.

MWSU's 4-0 run to end the first half would develop into an 8-0 run, as the Griffons tallied the opening four points of the half for a 43-33 lead. They would lead by 10 (47-37) with seven minutes left in the third quarter before the Lady Chaps would chip away at the deficit. Foster converted on a three-point play, which was followed by field goals from Cox and Audrey Robertson for a 7-0 run to trail 47-44 with 6:11 left in the quarter. They would eventually take a lead in the quarter, as Maddox had a steal-and-score with 2:29 to go in the quarter for a 57-56 lead. LCU had a pair of two-point leads in the final two minutes of the quarter, but Murray nailed a three-pointer to put MWSU up 63-60 with under a minute left in the quarter. Taylor Thomas had an and-one three-point play to send the game into the fourth quarter tied 63-63. Foster had 12 points in the quarter off 4-of-5 shooting.

Foster's night was the finest scoring performance since Emily Pool (Atkins) torched Northern New Mexico College for 36 points on Nov. 5, 2010. Each of those performances are tied for fourth in program history, as Beth Capps holds the program single-game scoring mark of 38 points from Jan. 22, 1996 (Capps is also one of two players to have a 37-point outing). Foster was 13-of-20 from the field (4-of-6 from long-range) and was 6-of-6 from the free-throw line (also had six rebounds and a trio of blocks). Her 13 field goals were the most by a Lady Chap since Kelsey Canavan had 13 field goals on Mar. 1, 2013 against Rogers State.

Foster was one of six Lady Chaps to have a career-high point outing Sunday. Whitney Cox, who entered the game following career-highs in points (6) and rebounds (6) Saturday, posted her first career double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds. She was missed late, as she fouled out with 2:03 left and the game tied 90-90. Robertson (15 points) and Maddox (13 points) were part of the mix with career-high production and joined Cox and Foster in double-figures.

LCU, shooting 49.2% from the field (31/63), was 29-of-33 (87.9%) from the free-throw line. The 29 free-throws were tied for the fifth-most since LCU began competing with a NCAA schedule (2013-14) and their highest mark since 30 against Lander last season (Nov. 19, 2021).

MWSU (1-1) received 34 points from Clarke, off a 12-of-19 shooting performance. She also completed a double-double with 12 rebounds. Clarke's performance, which was the sixth-best point performance in MWSU history, was the most by an opposing player against LCU since Addy Clift had 35 points against the Lady Chaps at Oklahoma Christian on February 17, 2018. The Griffons, coached by former Texas Tech head coach Candi Whitaker, also received 15 points from Murray, as MWSU had five players in double-figures offensively.

The Lady Chaps, dropping the first-ever meeting between the two programs, fell to 0-2 with the loss. It is LCU last opened the season 0-2 during the 2016-17 campaign.

TURNING POINT

While LCU never led by more than four points, they trailed as much as 10 points in the contest. Overcoming a seven-point deficit in the fourth quarter to at least take a lead Saturday, LCU was able to overcome their largest deficit (10 points) in the second half Sunday. Trailing 47-37 with 6:56 left in the third quarter, LCU was able to answer a 4-0 Griffons run with Foster's three-point play. It was the first a three consecutive field goal attempts by the Lady Chaps, and it was part of an 8-of-9 shooting stretch to help LCU march back and take a 60-58 lead.
