### SHOW ME THE SEASON OPENER

The 20th season in Steve Gomez's history at Lubbock Christian University opens in Kansas City, Mo., with LCU taking part in the D2CCA Tip-Off Classic facing Missouri Southern Friday (3:30 p.m.) and Missouri Western Saturday (5:30 p.m.) inside Municipal Auditorium. The classic/tournament is the first of three LCU will participate in during the regular season. LCU heads home for their first home game on Nov. 11, as LCU hosts the Carpet Tech Classic.

### **UNFAMILIAR ENDING**

The Lady Chaparrals are coming off a 28-7 season from 2021-22. LCU made the NCAA South Central

Regional for the sixth time in program history, but a 59-54 loss in the regional championship game to No.19 West Texas A&M marked their first regional loss in program history. Highlights of last season included a 76-72 home win over No.1 Lander on Nov. 19 at home to help keep their NCAA Division II record home win streak intact. The win streak is still in tact at 104 consecutive home wins.

### **WHO RETURNS**

The Lady Chaps roster of 13 student-athletes consists of nine returners and four new additions. Of the nine returnees, three (Audrey Robertson, Grace Foster and Maci Maddox) averaged over 10 minutes per game last season. Robertson made

three starts last season, during a stretch in which All-American Allie Schulte missed four games due to injury, and had a trio of double-digit appearances last season, including a 12-point outing against No.1 Lander. The final sister (of a trio of Robertson sisters) remaining on roster, she averaged 4.3 points per game last season. Foster, who was named to the 2022-23 LSC Women's Basketball Preseason Players to Watch list, became LCU's first recipient to the LSC All-Freshman Team last season, as she appeared in all 35 games off the bench and averaged 7.4 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. She led LCU in blocks (28), ranking in the top-10 in the LSC, Maddox appeared in 31 games last season and was successful at a rate of 47.6% from three-point range during the season (10/21). Whitney Cox is LCU's lone senior on the roster, although she has an option to exercise her choice to play another season (due to COVID). Cox played in 31 games last season and produced 10 blocks.

### WHO THEY LOST

For the first time since taking over the Lady Chaps, head coach Steve Gomez must replace all five of his starters, as Laynee Burr, Channing Cunyus, Ashton Duncan, Juliana Robertson and Allie Schulte completed their collegiate careers last season. All five of the starters were part of two of LCU's three NCAA Division II titles and combined for 4,675 career points. Allie Schulte (1,587 points in 155 career games) departed as LCU's all-time leader in three-point shooting percentage (.444) and also ranked second in steals (320) and fourth in assists (421). Duncan (1,101 points in 138 games) left as LCU's career leader in three-pointers (276).

### **NEW FACES**

LCU has four new additions seeking their Lady Chaparrals debut. Deja Johnson, Tia Johnson, Martie McCoy and Taylor Thomas are part of the 2022-23 incoming class. Twin sisters Deia Johnson and Tia Johnson add local flavor to the roster and continue LCU's trend of having sisters on the roster. The Johnson sisters were part of Brownfield High School's 2020-21 UIL State Championship squad. McCoy joins the Lady Chaps from Muenster High School (Muenster, Texas), where she also was the kicker for the Hornets football program. A multiple All-State recipient was a member of the 2A UIL State Tournament All-Tournament Team in 2019-20 (as a sophomore), as Muenster finished as the state runner-up. Thomas continues a trend of Canvon High School products on the LCU roster (currently the only one, as Channing

Cunyus and Brylee Winfrey were Canyon products on the roster last season). Another freshman with All-State and UIL State Tournament All-Tournament Team honors, Thomas was part of Canyon's 2020-21 UIL State Championship program.

### **NATIONALLY KNOWN**

D2SIDA (Division II Sports Information Directors Association) and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) each announced their preseason top-25 rankings for the 2022-2023 season, with D2SIDA ranking Lubbock Christian University No.13 and the WBCA ranking the Lady Chaparrals No.23.

LCU has found their way into the D2SIDA preseason poll nine consecutive seasons, marking every season they have been eligible to appear (due to the transfer from NAIA to NCAA Div. II), ranking No.1 (2019-20 and in 2021-22), No.3 (2018-19 and in 2020-21), No.23 (2017-18), No. 4 (2016-17), No.15 (2015-16) and receiving votes in 2014-15. The Lady Chaps No.13 ranking is the second-best among South Central Region programs, as West Texas A&M holds the No.7 ranking.

The WBCA NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Preseason Poll, which the WBCA did not conduct during the 2020-21 season (COVID), is a poll LCU has consistently debut in each season a poll has been conducted since being eligible. Carrying the No.1 ranking last season, this season's No.23 ranking ends a streak of three consecutive top-10 preseason poll appearances. Along with their three consecutive top-10 debuts (No.1 in 2021-22, No.2 in 2019-20, No. 10 in 2018-19), LCU has claimed No.11 (2016-17) and No.18 (2015-16) in their prior appearances in the poll.

### SO ARE SOME OTHERS

LCU will face a nationally ranked program Saturday, facing No.6 Southern Missouri, LCU went 6-0 against nationally ranked programs in 2020-21 and 3-2 in 2021-22 against the nations ranked foes (opened 3-0).

### **SEASON OPENERS**

LCU is probably more known for how they finish the season, than how they begin the season. The Lady Chaps are 9-6 over their last 15 season openers. LCU opened last season with a 69-55 win over Motevallo in Billings, Mont. (Nov. 5, 2021). LCU is 29-14 all-time and 13-6 under head coach Steve Gomez in openers. The 2017-18 season opener in Commerce, Texas marked LCU's last season opener that was against a national ranked opponent (LCU topped No.5 CSU-Pueblo 57-52).

### **EYE-OPENING**

The 2021-22 season marks LCU's 10th since leaving the NAIA and LCU is 242-36 record (87.1%) in that span. In NCAA postseason play, the Lady Chaps are 22-2 all-time.

### **SWEET HOME (ON) CHICAGO**

LCU went 13-0 at home last season, which has their active home win streak sitting at 104 games (it is the active and all-time leading mark in NCAA Division II women's basketball). LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason champions with a 19-3 conference record. They

### **FIVE THINGS ABOUT MSSU**

1 > The Lions are coming off 24-7 season in 2021-22, as they were MIAA regular season codropped their final two games of the season, falling in the MIAA championship game and to St. Cloud State in the NCAA Central Regional.

- **2** > Missouri Southern allowed a bucket at the horn, which forced overtime, and would end up falling 72-70 Tuesday at NCAA Division-I Wichita State. The Lions were led by Kaitlin Hunnicutt (15 points) and by Lacy Stokes (13 points and eight rebounds).
- **3** > MSSU has been picked to win the league in both the coaches and media polls as announced by the MIAA.
- **4** > The Lions return 10 players from last year's squad, including All-American Lacy Stokes, who was the MIAA Freshman and Player of the Year. She was also on the All-Defensive team by the MIAA last season, becoming the first women's basketball student-athlete in the conference's history to accomplish the feat after averaging 19.7 points, 5.7 rebound, 5.6 assists and 3.3 steals a game. Lacy set 18 program records for a freshman and became the first Lion ever to average at least 15.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists a game for a season.
- **5** > MSSU, 2-2 last season in neutral site play, last opened in a neutral site contest on Nov. 8, 2019, falling 79-70 to Henderson State.

### THE SERIES AGAINST MSSU

LCU is 1-0 all-time against MSSU. The only prior meeting was December 8, 2000, with LCU winning 62-53 in a neutral site contest in Portales, N.M. LCU is 6-3 all-time against Missouri based programs.

### PRIOR MEETING VS. MSSU

Portales, N.M. (December 8, 2000) – An unbeaten Missouri Southern was held to 26.7% shooting from the field and suffered their first loss of the 2000-01 season to LCU, who won 62-53 inside Greyhound Arena during the Zia Classic in Portales, N.M. Mamy N'Kolomoni led LCU with 18 points and Ginger Armacost supplied 16 points.

### **FIVE THINGS ABOUT MWSU**

- **1 >** The Griffins are coming off 24-10 season in 2021-22, posting a 14-8 conference record. They won the NCAA Division II Central Regional tournament and advanced to the Elite Eight for the first time since 1995. They fell to Grand Valley State.
- **2** > Missouri Western opens their season Saturday facing Minnesota Duluth in Kansas City before facing LCU Sunday.
- **3** > MWSU is picked to finish fourth in their conference in both the coaches and media polls as announced by the MIAA.
- 4 > The Griffons are coached by former Texas Tech Lady Raider Candi Whitaker. The former Texas Tech women's basketball head coach (2013-18) took over the Griffons program in 2019 and is heading into her fourth season at MWSU. Steve Gomez and Whitaker have only faced each other in scrimmages. LCU assistant coach Kaycie Wilson (Boyles) played three seasons (2009 2012) for Whitaker at Missouri Kansas City (UMKC). UMKC played a portion of their home games at Municipal Auditorium during Whitaker's time there. This trip for LCU is Wilson's first trip back to Municipal Auditorium since she played at UMKC. 5 > MWSU's roster consists of a trio of Division I transfers, as Johnni Gonzalez (Cal-Santa Barbara), Brionna Budgetts (Central Arkansas) and Trinity Knapp (Missouri State) add Division I experience to the Griffins.

### THE SERIES AGAINST MWSU

The two programs have never met. LCU plays Missouri based programs in consecutive games for the first time since facing Central Missouri and Drury at the Elite Eight in Columbus, Ohio (2021).

### **VIC SELF** ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boy's basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at East-

ern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching bas-ketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011. Self has been on staff for all three of LCU's national titles.

The 2022-23 season marks Steve Gomez's 20th season at the helm of the Lady Chaps and the 10th season at the NCAA level. He opens the campaign with a 476-132 record, which includes a 22-2 record in NCAA postseason play.

In his first 10 seasons at the helm, as LCU was an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship Tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.



LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the winning tadition did not change. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season.

That led to an astounding 2015-2016 season, which was a season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No.1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually their first NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2016-17 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the champion-ship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tour-

nament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D, ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament champion-ship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season

LCU's title defense was rudely interrupted by the COVID Pandemic in 2019-20. LCU was 28-3 and claimed the Lone Star Conference Championship during their first season in the conference. LCU was chosen to host the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals for a third time, but the COVID shutdown halted the remainder of the season less than 24 hours prior to the first tournament game.

COVID went from being a wall to a hurdle in 2020-21, and one the Lady Chaps would be able to jump over. Through many cancellations and unknowns, LCU claimed a Lone Star Conference title and went to Canyon, Texas, where they claimed a NCAA Division II South Central title and a berth to another NCAA Elite Eight Tournament in Columbus, Ohio. It was there, LCU would claim their third national title, with wins over Daeman, Central Missouri and Drury to complete a 23-0 perfect season. They were the first NCAA Division II program to complete two undefeated season.

The Lady Chaps were preseason favorites to open the 2021-22 season. LCU surpassed a NCAA Div.II record 100 consecutive home wins during the season, which ended at the South Central Regional with LCU falling in the title game to conclude the season with a 28-7 record. Lubbock Christian closed the 2021-22 season holding a 242-36 record (87.1%) since leaving the NAIA

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific. LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University. In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU. They had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near-thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded. In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAÍA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an atlarge bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds



### **KAYCIE WILSON** - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She has played an integral role in the coaching staff for all three NCAA national championships. Wilson was named to the Dave Campbell's Texas Basketball Top-40 Coaches Under-40 List in 2021. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in Under 40 List in 2021. Site spent thet settlor season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No.45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No.55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

ATT LOO graduate, Golfied, Was a standard permitter player in Codari and Coperation in the fact stock, and to find subject the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an gan at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 31 years, and the couple has two sons: Hayden and Landon. Landon serves on the women's basketball coaching staff at Texas Tech.
