BE THEIR GUEST

No.18 Lubbock Christian University takes a 2-2 record to Weatherford, Okla. Monday, for a 5:30 p.m. tip against Southwestern Oklahoma State inside Pioneer Cellular Event Center. The game is the home opener for SWOSU and it is also LCU's first true road game of the season. LCU went 9-5 in road games last season, going 3-0 in non-conference road games.

SMALL BREAK

LCU has not played since a 76-58 home win over Colorado State Pueblo on Nov. 12. LCU has won their last two games, claiming wins at the Carpet Tech Classic. LCU was able to shoot a season-best 51.1% from the field in the win over CSUP

WILL AND GRACE

After a season-opening weekend, which included a 36-point performance against Missouri Western State, Grace Foster had a pair of solid performances in LCU's 2-0 mark at the Carpet Tech Classic. Foster led LCU, the only team that went 2-0 at the event, with 16.5 points and 10.5 rebounds a

game. Against Colorado Christian, she produced 10 rebounds and she followed with 11 rebounds and 25 points against CSU Pueblo. The 25-point outing was the highest single-game scoring performance by a LSC individual over the week. Her average of 10.5 rebounds (8.5 defensive rebounds per game) led all LSC performers on the week, and she led all players going 14-of-14 from the free-throw line.

SEASON NOTES AND TRENDS

> Grace Foster is one of 71 players meeting the statistical minimums to qualify among the statistical NCAA Division II leaders with a perfect 100% free-throw shooting percentage. Foster, who is second in the LSC in scoring at 21.3 points per game (36th nationally), is the only Division II player with a 100% free-throw percentage with at least 20 attempts, as she is 20-of-20 this season.

> Maci Maddox has posted career-high scoring totals in her prior three games, scoring 13 points against Missouri Western State followed with 14 points in contests against Colorado Christian and CSU Pueblo. She is 4-of-8 from long range during the stretch and is averaging 5.0 assists and 3.3 steals per game.

> The Lady Chaps are averaging 40.5 rebounds per game through their opening pair of contests, posting a high of 46 against Missouri Southern State (Nov. 5). LCU has not averaged over 40 rebounds in a season since averaging 40.3 during the 2015-16 season. Grace Foster (9.5), Whitney Cox (5.5) and Audrey Robertson (5.3) are all averaging 5.0-or-more rebounds per game.

> LCU has a 94-52 scoring advantage from the line this season against their opposition. They have at least 20 points scored from the line in their three prior games. On the campaign, LCU is shooting 79.7% (94/118) from

the line, which leads the LSC and ranks 27th nationally. Grace Foster is 20-of-20 from the line this season to lead LCU from the line. Shaylee Stovall (18-of-21, 85.7%) and Audrey Robertson (20-of-24, 83.3%) are each shooting over 83.0% from the line (of those reaching minimum requirements). They rank fourth nationally with an average of 23.5 free-throws made per game. LCU's opponents are shooting 77.6% from the line, which leads the LSC as well.

> The Lady Chaps are averaging 80.3 points per contest (averaged 65.9 per game last season), which ranks second in the LSC, and they have a trio of players averaging double figures in points. Grace Foster (21.3), Maci Maddox (12.3) and Audrey Robertson (12.0) lead the average scoring pace for the Lady Chaps.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

D2SIDA (Division II Sports Information Directors Association) and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) each have LCU in their Top-25 national polls, as D2SIDA has Lubbock Christian ranked No.18 and the WBCA ranking has Lady Chaparrals No.23.

The D2SIDA poll, which had LCU debuting at No.13 in their preseason poll, has already announced their first in-season poll, while the WBCA has only conducted a preseason poll.

The WBCA NCAA Division II Women's Basketball Preseason Poll, which the WBCA did not conduct during the 2020-21 season (COVID), is a poll LCU has consistently debut in each season a poll has been conducted since being eligible. Carrying the No.1 ranking last season, this season's No.23 ranking ends a streak of three consecutive top-10 preseason poll appearances. Along with their three consecutive top-10 debuts (No.1 in 2021-22, No.2 in 2019-20, No.10 in 2018-19), LCU has claimed No.11 (2016-17) and No.18 (2015-16) in their prior appearances in the poll.

SO ARE SOME OTHERS

LCU faced a nationally ranked program in their season opener (Nov.5), falling to No.6 Southern Missouri State. LCU went 6-0 against nationally ranked programs in 2020-21 and 3-2 in 2021-22 against the nations ranked foes (opened 3-0). LCU's season opener marked the first time since the 2017-18 season opener in Commerce, Texas in which LCU

opened against a national ranked opponent (LCU topped No.5 CSU-Pueblo 57-52). Three of LCU's four games this season have been against nationally ranked teams or teams receiving votes.

SWEET HOME (ON) CHICAGO

LCU, who went 13-0 at home last season, is 2-0 at home this season, which has their active home win streak sitting at 106 games (it is the active and all-time leading mark in NCAA Division II women's basketball). LCU's last home loss came on Jan. 1, 2015 against Oklahoma City University. LCU, who also has a 7-0 mark in NCAA postseason play in Lubbock in the mix (not including a 4-0 mark in LSC postseason play), has also won 82 consecutive home conference games, with their last conference home loss occurring Jan. 10, 2013 (against Oklahoma City). They completed a 49-0 all-time mark in Heartland Conference home games (they are 29-0 in LSC home games).

FIVE THINGS ABOUT SWOSU

1 > The Bulldogs enter Monday's tilt 0-3 on the season (their first 0-3 start since 2015-16). They are coming off a 29-5 season and a 20-2 Great American Conference record. SWOSU won the GAC Championships and clinched a Central Regional appearance, where they lost to Missouri Western in the opening round.

2 > Southwestern Oklahoma State was preseason picked to finish fifth in the GAC preseason poll. They were one of three GAC programs to receive first-place votes.

3 > SWOSU is opening their home slate by hosting LCU. They went 13-0 at home last season and have a 13-game home win streak.

4 > Like LCU, SWOSU has the unique statistic in which they lead their conference (Lone Star for LCU and GAC for SWOSU) in opposing team free-throw percentage, as SWOSU opponents have combined to shoot 77.6% from the line.

5 > Morgan Smith, who posted 19 points against Pittsburg State, leads SWOSU averaging 13.7 points per game. Her career-high is 20 points, which she completed twice last season.

THE SERIES AGAINST SWOSU

LCU is 6-3 all-time against SWOSU, with LCU winning the prior three meetings. The most memorable contest between the two programs was on Mar. 29, 2019 in Columbus, Ohio, where LCU topped SWOSU in double overtime (95-85) to claim the 2019 NCAA Division II national title. The previous meeting was also in postseason play, as LCU topped

SWOSU 78-65 in Canyon, Texas at the South Central Regional Championship Game (SWOSU was in LCU's region due to COVID postseason realignment). LCU is 1-2 all-time in Weatherford against SWOSU, with the Bulldogs winning the prior two meetings (Dec. 3, 2018 was the previous meeting in Weatherford, where SWOSU won 77-75).

ACTIVE LADY CHAP LEADERS VS. SWOSU

No active Lady Chaps have appeared in any prior meetings against SWOSU.

PRIOR MEETING VS. SWOSU

CANYON, Texas (March 15, 2021) - On a night the outside shots were not falling, top-seeded Lubbock Christian University needed inside shooters to complete the task...and they did. Lady Chaparrals forward Emily Middleton led all scorers with 22 points, and Juliana Robertson posted her first double-double (16 points and 12 rebounds), as LCU came back from an eight-point second half deficit and used a 15-0 run for a 78-65 win over No.2-seeded and No.19 Southwestern Oklahoma State.

LCU's Allie Schulte and Ashton Duncan, who

each had over 20 points in Saturday's semifinal victory over Cameron, were each 0-of-6 from the field in the first half. Juliana Robertson carried the weight for the Lady Chaps in the half, scoring 12 points in the first quarter and 14 in the half to help LCU take a 36-33 halftime lead. Despite a scoreless half, Schulte's defensive play was rewarding for the team, as she had three steals and helped LCU outscore the Bulldogs 12-4 in points-off-turnovers in the half.

The three-pointers were not falling in the opening half. SWOSU entered the contest with a NCAA Division II leading 11.1 three-pointers per game, but they were 2-of-7 from three-point range in the half (opened the game 1-of-6 and 2-of-10 from long range). LCU was 3-of-18 in the half from long range and eventually 3-of-22 after their first four attempts of the second half did not fall.

The lack of success from outside for each team, had them working in the paint. Robertson (14) and Middleton (8) combined for 22 points in the first half, with Channing Cunyus also coming off the bench to pitch in four points in the half. LCU was 12-of-18 (67%) inside the arc in the half. SWOSU was 13-of-24 (54.1%) inside the perimeter, with Bethany Franks leading the Bulldogs in paint scoring (7 points) in the half.

The Lady Chaps went nearly six minutes without a field goal in the third quarter, as SWOSU started to surge. Franks hit a pair of three-pointers for the Bulldogs, which book-ended a 13-2 SWOSU run for a 50-42 Bulldogs lead. The eight-point deficit marked the largest second half deficit the Lady Chaps have faced this season.

Flashback to the prior two meetings between these two teams: Mar. 29, 2019 – In the NCAA Division II national championship game, LCU faced a 10-point deficit to SWOSU in the second half. They rallied back to eventually win the thriller in double overtime by 10 points.

Nov. 16, 2019 – In a meeting inside Rip Griffin Center in Lubbock, LCU faced a 52-46 deficit with 1:10 left in the third quarter and trailed 52-47 in the fourth quarter before LCU outscored SWOSU 24-9 in the fourth quarter for a 10-point LCU victory.

Monday, as shots were not falling, LCU used their grit to climb from their deficit. LCU was 3-of-9 from the field in the quarter, but they earned 12 free-throw attempts and made all 12 (Middleton 8-for-8 in the quarter) to have 12 of their 18 points in the quarter scored from the line. LCU scored the final six points of the quarter from the line and cut SWOSU's lead to 56-54 at quarter's end.

In the fourth quarter, LCU was finally able to dial in from long range. They opened the quarter on a 9-0 run, with Duncan ending a personal sequence of seven straight misses from downtown with a three-pointer to cap the run at 15-0 for a 63-56 LCU lead. Duncan connected on another less than two minutes later, followed with a wide-open Madelyn Turner also connecting for a 71-60 lead with 5:40 remaining.

Outside of Laynee Burr's bucket to open the fourth quarter scoring, LCU outscored SWOSU 24-9 in the fourth quarter with 20 of the points coming from their five seniors. SWOSU was 2-of-12 (16.7%) in the fourth quarter, with their last field goal put in with less than 10 seconds left in the game.

LCU was 18-for-18 at the free-throw line until missing their final attempt, which placed the nation's leading free-throw shooting team with a single-game season high 18-for-19 (94.7%) night at the line, which is a program record for NCAA postseason play.

Macy Gore led SWOSU with 17 points, with Bethany Franks (13) and Makyra Tramble (12) combining for 25 points.

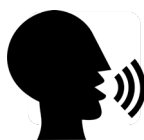

The 2022-23 season marks Steve Gomez's 20th season at the helm of the Lady Chaps and the 10th season at the NCAA level. He opens the campaign with a 476-132 record, which includes a 22-2 record in NCAA postseason play.

In his first 10 seasons at the helm, as LCU was an NAIA institution, the Lady Chaps made 10 consecutive trips to the NAIA Division I Women's Basketball National Championship Tournament. Coach Gomez's arrival to the LCU women's basketball program certainly changed the foundation of the program. In those 10 seasons, LCU posted a 234-96 record under Gomez in the NAIA.

LCU jumped into NCAA Division II transition in 2013 (membership in 2015) and the winning tradition did not change. LCU went a remarkable 25-1 overall in 2013-2014 and they completed the Heartland Conference with a perfect 20-0 mark for their first perfect conference record in program history. They followed in 2014-2015 claiming Co-Heartland Conference Regular Season title honors after a 15-3 stretch in conference and a 21-7 overall season.

That led to an astounding 2015-2016 season, which was a season that started off with an exhibition game loss at NCAA Div. I No. 1 Connecticut and ended with a perfect 35-0 season in LCU's first season eligible for NCAA postseason. They went 18-0 in Heartland Conference play to capture a regular season title and then a Heartland Conference Tournament title (first season eligible for the tournament). The Lady Chaps went on to capture a South Central Regional Tournament title and eventually their first NCAA Div. II National Title. Gomez claimed WBCA NCAA Div. II National Coach of the Year honors and also spent a portion of the offseason as a court coach at the 2016 USA Basketball Women's U17 World Championship Team Trials in Colorado Springs, Colo.

2016-17 served as a rebuilding year for the Lady Chaps, who returned one starter off the championship squad. Despite the rebuilding, LCU still went 19-11 overall and 12-4 in conference, en route to the Heartland Conference Tournament championship game, which they lost to St. Edward's. They bounced back in 2017-18, claiming another Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, leading to Gomez receiving Heartland Conference Coach of the Year honors. The Lady Chaps hosted the NCAA Division II South Central Region Tournament for a second time and won the tournament to stamp their second berth towards an NCAA Division II Elite Eight Tournament loss. They lost to eventual national champion Central Missouri at the tournament held in Sioux Falls, S.D., ending their season with a 31-2 record.

The Lady Chaps returned to the Elite Eight Tournament for the third year in a four-year span in the 2018-19 season after claiming a Heartland Conference regular season and tournament title, along with a NCAA Division II South Central Region tournament championship after wins at Colorado Mesa and at home over Angelo State. LCU made an outstanding run towards their second NCAA Division II National Title, defeating Southwestern Oklahoma State in double overtime to claim the trophy. Gomez, who picked up his third Heartland Coach of the Year honor, became the seventh head coach in NCAA Division II women's basketball history to claim multiple titles. He also was named Female Team Coach of the Year at the West Texas Sports Persons of the Year Banquet following the season.

LCU's title defense was rudely interrupted by the COVID Pandemic in 2019-20. LCU was 28-3 and claimed the Lone Star Conference Championship during their first season in the conference. LCU was chosen to host the NCAA Division II South Central Regionals for a third time, but the COVID shutdown halted the remainder of the season less than 24 hours prior to the first tournament game.

COVID went from being a wall to a hurdle in 2020-21, and one the Lady Chaps would be able to jump over. Through many cancellations and unknowns, LCU claimed a Lone Star Conference title and went to Canyon, Texas, where they claimed a NCAA Division II South Central title and a berth to another NCAA Elite Eight Tournament in Columbus, Ohio. It was there, LCU would claim their third national title, with wins over Daemen, Central Missouri and Drury to complete a 23-0 perfect season. They were the first NCAA Division II program to complete two undefeated seasons.

The Lady Chaps were preseason favorites to open the 2021-22 season. LCU surpassed a NCAA Div. II record 100 consecutive home wins during the season, which ended at the South Central Regional with LCU falling in the title game to conclude the season with a 28-7 record. Lubbock Christian closed the 2021-22 season holding a 242-36 record (87.1%) since leaving the NAIA.

In their final two seasons in the NAIA (2011-2012, 2012-2013), LCU set program single-season win records in each of the seasons. The Lady Chaps went 31-4 in 2013-2014, setting a program single-season wins mark (31). The Lady Chaps won their first ever Sooner Athletic Conference Tournament title en route to their final trip to the NAIA National Championship tournament. In 2011-2012, LCU went 28-6 and made their second ever appearance in the Semifinals of the NAIA National Championship Tournament. They lost out to eventual national champions Oklahoma City to mark the second consecutive season in which they lost out to the team who would claim the title. LCU claimed their second Sooner Athletic Conference crown in program history, as they joined Oklahoma City as conference co-champions with a 21-1 record. They handed OCU their only loss of the season.

LCU went 25-10 in 2010-2011 and marched into the Elite Eight for a third time in program history. The Lady Chaps, who finished third in the Sooner Athletic Conference, lost in the NAIA National Championship to eventual national champion Azusa Pacific. LCU went 19-12 in the 2009-2010 season, which included a 13-9 finish in the Sooner Athletic Conference, and had their season come to an end in the National Tournament. The highlight of the season was an exhibition victory inside the United Spirit Arena against Texas Tech University. In 2009-2010, the Lady Chaps finished with a solid 27-7 record and made a trip to the Sweet Sixteen of the National Tournament following a second-place Sooner Athletic Conference season. Gomez chalked up a milestone during the season, becoming the all-time women's basketball wins leader at LCU. They had a memorable 2007-2008 campaign, as the Lady Chaps made another voyage to the NAIA National Tournament. The Lady Chaps completed a 25-10 season, which included a trip to the Elite Eight in the tournament for their second best finish in program history.

In 2006-2007, Gomez led the Lady Chaps to a myriad of firsts in their near-thirty year history. Lubbock Christian never left the top-10 in the NAIA National Poll, and set a school mark for wins in a season with 26, eclipsing the school mark of 23 they set the prior season. In addition, LCU made its fourth consecutive trip to the NAIA National Tournament, finishing in the Sweet Sixteen and most impressively, the Lady Chaps captured a share of the Sooner Athletic Conference regular season championship, becoming the first school from outside of the State of Oklahoma to do so in the thirty-one years since the conference was founded. In 2005-2006, Gomez's Lady Chaps enjoyed what was arguably at the time the best season in school history, as they finished with an overall record of 23-12, and made an unparalleled run at the NAIA National Tournament. Seeded sixth in their eight team bracket in the tournament, Gomez's girls proceeded to oust four of the top six teams in the nation and become the lowest seed ever to reach either the Fab Four or National Championship; appropriately enough, he was named the SAC's Coach of the Year.

In his first season, Gomez's Lady Chaps went 16-14 and finished fifth in the Sooner Athletic Conference. While this might appear to be an average year, big wins for the Lady Chaps and entry into the NAIA National Poll for the first time proved good enough for an at-large bid to the NAIA National Tournament: LCU women's first trip to the big dance. In his second season, the Lady Chaps were able to maintain that level of success. After getting off to the best conference start since joining the Sooner Athletic Conference at 6-2, LCU finished SAC play at 10-8, good enough for another fifth place finish, and for the second season in a row, Coach Gomez guided the Lady Chaps to the NAIA National Tournament.

An LCU graduate, Gomez was a standout perimeter player for Coach John Copeland in the late 1980s, and to this day, he still holds the school record for career free throw percentage at .855. He graduated in 1988 with a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Mathematics and consistently used his degree to teach in the classroom while pursuing coaching on the sidelines. Gomez's career began at Lubbock Monterey High School where he served as an assistant coach in the men's basketball program from 1988 to 1995. In 1996, Gomez accepted the men's basketball head coaching position at Lubbock Cooper High School, where he remained until returning to Lubbock Christian University to take over the reigns of the Lady Chaps in 2003. During his seven seasons at Cooper, the basketball program broke new ground making the playoffs four times, managing the school's first state ranking, and capturing the Pirates only district championship in Gomez's final season. One of the main reasons Coach Gomez is so successful on the court is the support he receives off of it. Steve has been married to his wife Shawna for 31 years, and the couple has two sons: Hayden and Landon. Landon serves on the women's basketball coaching staff at Texas Tech.



VIC SELF ASSISTANT COACH

Self is a longtime familiar face to basketball among the South Plains. He spent 25 years coaching basketball at Lubbock's Monterey High School and 20 spent as the head coach of the Plainsmen boys' basketball team. Self is no stranger to LCU. The Portales, New Mexico native lettered in basketball and tennis at Lubbock Christian in 1980-1981, after spending two years at Eastern New Mexico University. His first coaching job was as an assistant coach for John Copeland on the Chaps basketball staff. In two decades at Monterey, Self compiled a 416-237 record, four district titles and 13 playoff appearances. Monterey even made a trip to the regional tournament. He rejoins Gomez, but in a reversal of roles. Gomez served as an assistant for Self from 1988-1996. Self resigned from coaching basketball in 2008, but continued to coach boy's golf at Monterey until retiring in 2011. Self has been on staff for all three of LCU's national titles.

KAYCIE WILSON - ASSISTANT COACH

Kaycie joined the LCU women's basketball coaching staff in the 2014-15 season as a graduate assistant through the 2015-16 season. She has played an integral role in the coaching staff for all three NCAA national championships. Wilson was named to the Dave Campbell's Texas Basketball Top-40 Coaches Under-40 List in 2021. She spent her senior season (2013-14) playing in the interior of LCU's first season in the Heartland Conference, which went 20-0 in conference for a regular season first place finish. She spent three seasons (09/10 - 11/12) at NCAA Div. I Missouri-Kansas City, where she combined to average 4.9 points and 3.9 rebounds in 87 games. The forward also combined for 44 steals, 95 assists and 34 blocks for UMKC (21 blocks as a sophomore). Boyles was a multiple recipient on The Summit League Winter/Spring Academic All-League Team and the Commissioner's List of Academic Excellence as a distinguished scholar. She is a Lubbock native and a product of Coronado High School, where she was rated the No. 45 best forward in the nation by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report and the No. 55 best player in Texas by Premier Basketball Report. The multi-winning All-State recipient was named the Girls Basketball Player of the Year by the Lubbock Avalanche Journal, as well as the 2009 5A-4A All-South Plains Player of the Year after 17.6 points and 7.9 rebounds a game.

Grace Amazes, But Lady Chaps Fall In Overtime to Missouri Western State

Grace Foster Scores 36 Points and Is One of Six Lady Chaps To Notch Career-High Offensive Marks

Grace Foster posted 16 of her 25 points in the second half and added 11 rebounds to complete a double-double to help lead No.13 Lubbock Christian University to a 76-58 win over Colorado State Pueblo in the final game of the Carpet Tech Classic Saturday evening inside Rip Griffin Center. The home victory extended the nation's active-lead-home win streak to 106 consecutive wins.

Foster, with 11 points in the third quarter, posted her second performance of over 20 points and second double-double of the season (in four games played). She had a team-leading +24 plus/minus in the contest while going 7-of-15 from the field. Foster was 3-of-5 from long range and 8-of-8 from the free-throw line.

LCU was in a fight early, just as they were in their Friday evening win over Colorado Christian. CSU Pueblo had leads of 14-12 and 16-14 in the opening quarter behind eight points in the frame by Charisse Fairley. Meanwhile, LCU was seeking to overcome a 4-of-15 (26.7%) start from the field. Foster helped spark the offense with her first field goal coming on a three-pointer with less than 30 seconds remaining in the quarter to give LCU a 17-16 lead heading into the second quarter.

The three-pointer helped start a 5-0 run, which was part of a 13-2 run to put LCU up 27-18 nearly three minutes into the second quarter. Denver City, Texas native Morgan Dial ended an 8-0 portion of the run with a three-pointer for CSU Pueblo, but Rachel Haase answered with a three-pointer, which sparked another 5-0 LCU run (put them up 32-21 with 4:42 left in the half. The ThunderWolves were held without a field goal for the final 2:45 of the half and LCU took a 40-28 lead into the break. Maci Maddox led LCU in the half with 10 points.

Fairly, who had 13 points in the first half for CSU Pueblo, scored CSU Pueblo's first five points of the second half, but Foster had a sequence of seven straight points fit in between Fairly's two field goals to build LCU's lead to 47-30. Foster finished with 11 points in the quarter and LCU led 59-40 at the completion of the quarter.

Midway through the fourth quarter, the T'Wolves had an 8-2 run to cut LCU's lead to 70-56 with 2:30 remaining, but LCU responded with a three-pointer from Shaylee Stovall and Foster sealed the game and a perfect night at the line with a pair of makes from the charity stripe.

Along with Foster's stellar evening, the Lady Chaps received 14 points each from Maddox and Audrey Robertson. Maddox's total matched her career-high total set Friday against Colorado Christian. LCU outscored CSU Pueblo 34-20 in paint-scoring, with Foster attributing to the number. Foster also led LCU with 11 rebounds, as they out-rebounded the T'Wolves 39-27. LCU shot a season-best 51.1% (24/47) from the line (they shot 50% or better five times last season).

CSU Pueblo (0-2) was held to a 34.5% (19/55) shooting performance in the game, which is the third time LCU has held an opponent to under 40-percent from the field. Fairley, a Fresno State transfer, led CSU Pueblo with 18 points.

The Lady Chaps improved to 4-0 all-time in Lubbock against CSU Pueblo and they are 8-4 all-time against the T'Wolves. LCU completed the weekend 2-0 at the Carpet Tech Classic to move to 2-2 overall on the season.

TURNING POINT

Foster's three-pointer to end the first quarter marked the first of an eventual four straight successfully made field goal attempts by the Lady Chaps. Over a span of 13:49 (from 27 seconds remaining in the first quarter to 3:22 into the third quarter), LCU was 13-of-16 (81.3%) from the field. The Lady Chaps, not missing more than one consecutive attempt during the sequence, was able to outscore CSU Pueblo 35-17 during the stretch.
